Chaperone Information and Responsibilities

The Swim Omaha coaches arrange for transportation, hotel accommodations and meal selection sites. The following outlines obligations and responsibilities for chaperones to insure that athletes; exhibit appropriate behavior that reflects positively on the club, receive proper rest and nutrition, maintain the highest regards for health and safety of self and others and maintain a focus necessary for providing the best performance for all swimmers at the competition.

1. Supervise swimmers at all team activities, particularly when swimmers are away from the pool.
2. Supervise swimmers on the bus or other modes of transportation.
3. Supervise swimmers at hotels/motels.
4. Assist coaches in determining meal times, locations and making reservations when necessary.
5. Assist in insuring that athletes meet departure and arrival deadlines.
6. Assist coaches in determining special recreational excursions, activities and making reservations when necessary. All activities must be approved by the coaching staff. Any activity that may interfere with the swimming competition, including attending the finals, will not be approved.
7. Assist with enforcing the 10:00pm room curfew and lights out at 10:30pm deadline. Variations from these timelines must be approved by the coaching staff.
8. In the event of disciplinary action resulting in an athlete being restricted to the hotel/motel, a chaperone will be designated to remain with that athlete.
9. Refrain from the use of alcohol, tobacco, etc.
