There will be a break of at least two (2) hours between preliminaries and finals, with the pool being available for warm-up the last hour.

A warm up schedule for preliminaries will be sent to participating teams, following the deadline for entries.

Warm-ups will be conducted in accordance with Alaska Swimming warm-up/warm-down procedures.

Coaches/Officials

Meetings: There will be a coaches and officials meeting just prior to the beginning of the meet on Friday.

Eligibility: Open to all Alaska Swimmers ages 14&Under as of the first day of the competition and currently registered as athlete members with USA Swimming and Alaska Swimming or FINA. Swimmers must sign in the age bracket corresponding to their age on the first day of the meet. Swimmers must meet the Alaska Swimming time standards within the established qualifying period, September 1, 2008 – November 25, 2009.

Rules: 1. Current USA Swimming and Alaska Swimming rules shall govern this meet.

2. Swimmers may enter a total of seven (7) events, with no more than three (3) events per day. This is exclusive of relay events.
3. All events will be conducted as prelims and finals on the same day, with the exception of the 500 freestyle and the 400 IM, which will be conducted as timed finals/consolidated events, fastest to slowest, alternating girls and boys with the girls swimming first. All 10&Under events will be conducted as timed finals, during the preliminary session. All preliminary events will be consolidated by stroke and distance, but not by gender, and separated into individual ages for finals.
4. A team may enter no more than two (2) individually non-qualified swimmers per relay.
5. This meet will be run as a “no recall meet” and we will use the whistle start method. ‘Fly-over’ starts may be utilized during some prelims events at the discretion of the meet a/o deck referee.
6. Building and facility rules will be enforced. Due to limited deck space we ask that all swimmers keep a minimal amount of gear on deck.
7. Disabled swimmers who have met the Alaska disability time standards are encouraged to participate. Coaches should include with the team entries a copy of the Information Form for Disabled Swimmers (available on the ASI website), specifying the special needs of any adoptive swimmer(s) with the team entries. Bring such requests for non-standard entries to the attention of the Entries Chairman, Quniten Arndt.

Scratch Rules

1. Individual scratch rules for events will be in effect as stated in the “Alaska Swim Guide” posted on the Alaska Swimming website.(<http://www.teamunify.com/Home.jsp?team=wzaslsc>).
2. The relay scratch rule will be applied as stated in the “Alaska Swim Guide” posted on the Alaska Swimming website.

3. Scratches shall be made each day and delivered to the computer table as soon as possible.
4. A swimmer will be considered entered unless his/her coach has officially scratched him/her from the event.

Entry:

1. Email your entries on or before Wednesday, November 25, 2009 by using Hy-Tek software choosing the “Export/Meet entries” option along with the following attachments:

- a. A Team Manager “team entry report”
- b. A Team Manager “team meet fees report”

2. A name and telephone number of the entry contact person must be included with with entries.

3. If you do not have Team Manager, your entries may be emailed or mailed in time to arrive before Nov 25 on a consolidated form that includes the swimmers’ USASwimming identification number.

4. Athlete and coach verification forms must be signed and delivered to the computer desk prior to the start of the meet.

Scoring

7-5-4-3-2-1- for individual events

14-10-8-6-4-2 for relay events

Scores shall be awarded for 1st-6th place for each individual event, 1st-3rd for relay events.

Medals will be awarded for 1st-3rd place and ribbons for 4th-6th for individual events. Ribbons will be awarded for 1st-3rd for relay events.

A team trophy will be awarded for 1st-3rd combined team points. Separate awards based on points per swimmer and best times percentage will also

be awarded. A team must have six individual qualified swimmers to qualify for these two awards.

Award will be presented for 1st-3rd place in individual high-point awards.
