**MEET FORMAT** This will be a "Cardless" meet with double ended preliminaries.

**WARM UP PROCEDURES** SNC warm up procedures will be in effect at this meet.

**ELIGIBILITY** Swimmers must be registered in one of the SNC competitive categories (ie. No Seasonal or Pre-competitive swimmers).

### **TIME STANDARDS**

- \* There are no Standards for 50m and 100m events.
- \* Time standards are on the Event Listing page for 200m events. **Proof of Time required**
- \* 10 & under swimmers must have a 200IM time of faster than 4:00 to enter the meet.
- \* Open entries to Kamloops Classic swimmers.

**NUMBER OF EVENT'S:** Swimmers are limited to a **MAXIMUM OF 8** individual events.

### **DISTANCE EVENTS (400's, 800's & 1500's)**

Swimmers that don't make the entry cut for the distance events will be able to choose another event. We will notify coaches by email and you should watch for notification and published Pysch Sheets. The **onus is on the coach** to check this list.

### **REFUNDS**

No refund of fees for scratched events after the entry deadline **except** with a medical certificate. Credits for medical reasons will be provided after the meet.

**REGISTRATION DEADLINE: Thursday November 26, 2009.**

Meet management will close entries after receiving the **550<sup>th</sup>** swimmer.  
Teams will be notified if entries cannot be accepted.

**Meet entries must be uploaded prior to the entry deadline to the Swimming Canada [www.swimmeet.ca](http://www.swimmeet.ca) website. Entries sent directly to the Meet Manager will not be accepted. SNC will send a confirmation email back to the up – loader.**

Entry fee **invoices will be available at check-in.** The fees will reflect entries as of the Thursday November 26th deadline. Payment must be made by check-in on Friday December 11th. We accept cash, cheque, Interact, Visa or Mastercard. Cheque payable to "**Kamloops Aquatic Club**".

## **SPECIAL MEET RULES:**

1. This meet will follow SNC rules. The One Start Rule will be in effect and the current SNC Swimsuit policy will be observed.
2. A coaches meeting will be held prior to the start of Heats on Friday.
3. Coaches are asked to check in with the Meet Manager immediately upon arrival to pick up Meet Package and information regarding any changes.
4. Deck entries will be accepted to fill any empty lanes. Deck entries must be in the hands of the Meet Secretary one hour before session starts and they must include the swimmer's name, date of birth, and 9 digit SNC ID Number for swimmers not already in the meet.  
Deck entries are exhibition swims only.  
Cost: \$10.00 per individual events and \$12.00 per team for relay events, to be paid at time of registration.
5. Scratch procedure SNC Rule 3.4.1 will be in effect. (\$20.00)
6. All 10 & under events including relays will be swum as timed final events during the preliminaries and will be seeded slowest to fastest.
7. Relays will be swum as timed finals at the end of Finals.
8. Girl's 800 and Boy's 1500 free events will be seeded and awarded as Open Age Group events. They will be swum slowest to fastest in the Friday preliminaries as timed finals.
9. There will be Consolation Finals in events with 24 competitors or more as determined by the psych sheets in the following events: All 50's & 100's, 200 Free and 200IM.
10. These events will have finals only: 400 Free, 400 IM, 200 Back, 200 Breast, 200 Fly
11. Any act of theft, vandalism or similar action will result in immediate disqualification from the meet and the loss of any points accumulated towards team standings by the individual(s) involved.
12. During the meet **spectators and non-accredited coaches are not permitted on the pool deck** for insurance purposes. Use of flash cameras is not permitted at the start ends of the pool.
12. The Meet Management Committee reserves the right to move the 10 & under girls' events to the same end of the swim pool as the boys' events for the heats.
13. Meet Management reserves the right to limit the number of entries in the 200m events.
14. There will be Positive Check-Ins for all Distance Events (400's / 800's / 1500's) & Finals.
15. Volunteer Officials are welcome.

## **SCORING:**

Points for club standings will be assigned according to Club registration submitted.

Team scoring for Finals will be: 18-16-15-14-13-12-11-10

Team scoring for Consolations Finals will be: 9-7-6-5-4-3-2-1

Relay scoring will be: 36-32-30-28-26-24-22-20

10 & under swimmers: 9-7-6-5-4-3-2-1

## **AWARDS:**

-Age will be determined as of Friday, Dec. 11, 2009.

-Age groups will be: 10 & under, 12 & under, 14 & under, 15 & over.

-Medals will be awarded for 1<sup>st</sup>, 2<sup>nd</sup> and 3<sup>rd</sup> place; ribbons will be awarded for 4<sup>th</sup> through 8<sup>th</sup> place. Ribbons will be awarded for 1<sup>st</sup> 2<sup>nd</sup> and 3<sup>rd</sup> place relay teams.

-Best Time ribbons will be given to 10 & under swimmers.

-The winning team will receive the Ice Classic Cup; the "small team" with the most points will receive the Mini-Ice Classic Cup (definition of "small teams" to be announced at the start of the meet).

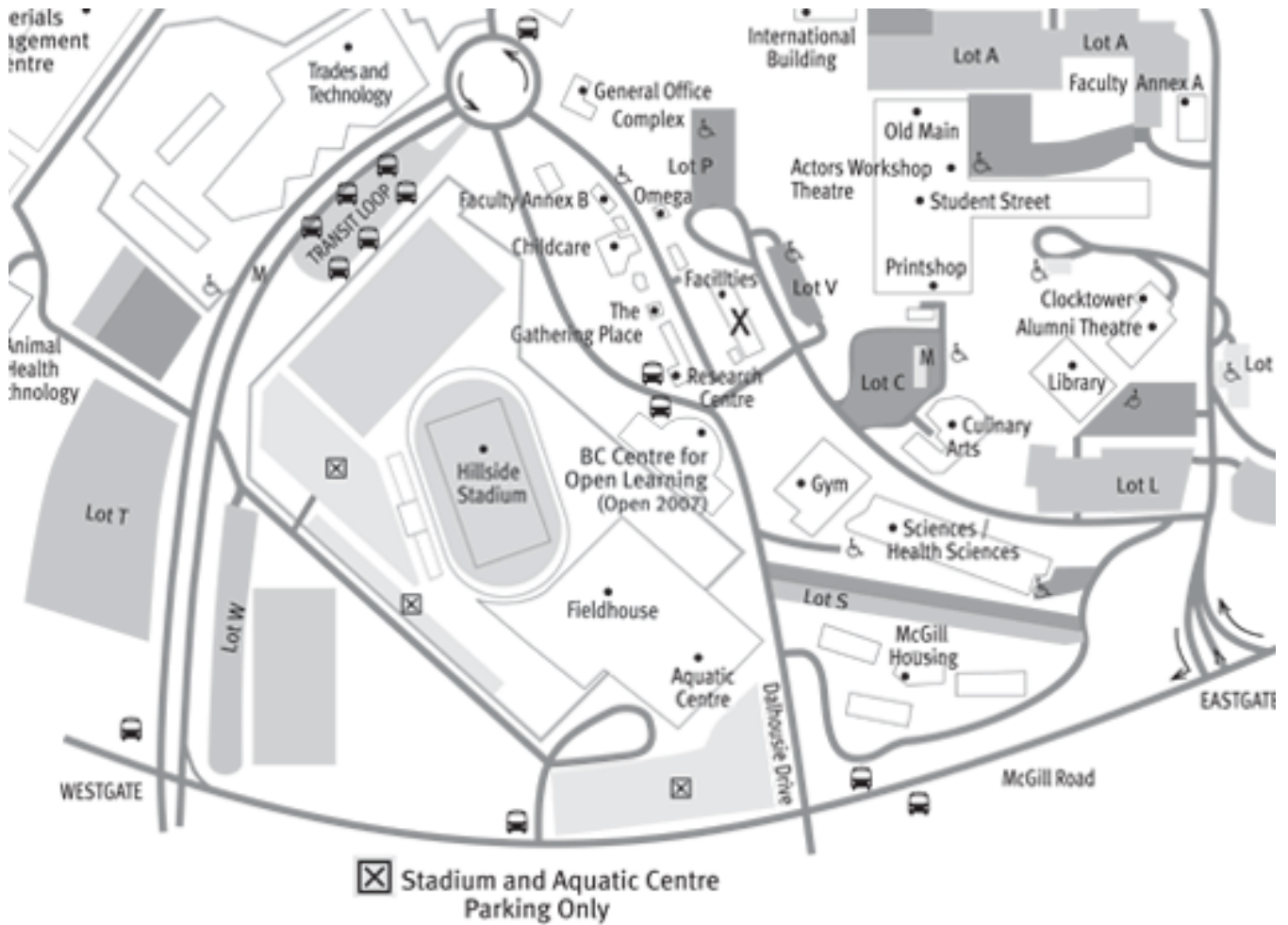
