- ❖ Fees can be paid by posted dated cheques or one time payment (5% discount on one time payment)
- ❖ Additional family members will receive 10% off monthly fees (masters excluded)
- ❖ All swimmers pay Swim BC insurance fees and HSSC Club Membership fee \$70(one per family)
- ❖ 30 days written notice to Registrar is required when leaving the program early (before June 30)

 - If my swimmers(s) participate I a competition that I am responsible for any entry fees, late scratch fees or upgrades in registration. Fees are due before swimmers compete.
- ❖ It is my responsibility to inform with written notice (MINIMUM 30 day) to the club Registrar if my swimmer quits before the end of the swim year:(June)
- ❖ That the club retains the right to refund registration fees within 30 days of registration should the swimmer not have the proficiency required for his/her age group

FAMILY PARTICIPATION PROGRAM (FPP)

FPP was designed to encourage families to get involved.

Based on the level of swimmer participation, each family will need to earn points throughout the swim year. Half the points will need to be earned in the first term of the season Sept-January. The other half of your points will need to be earned in the second term, Feb-June

Points can be earned by participating in club activities, officiating, or helping at swim meets, serving on the board, etc.

Each point is worth \$25. If you choose, you may pay for your points and not participate in any activities.

To encourage participation, each family's points monetary value will be assessed and divided over the 9 month swim season and added to your monthly fees. Money will be reimbursed at the end of each half season for points earned and paid for. (January 31 and June 30)

If you paid your fees in a lump sum, your points must be paid in a lump sum as well. No discount for lump sum FPP payments.

- ❖ Each point is assessed at \$25 and will be added to your monthly dues
- ❖ Broad members and committee members will earn half of their points in the first term and the other half in the second term
- ❖ Each family will be assessed the number of points of the most senior swimmer in their family
- ❖ Extra points earned in the first term can be carried forward to the second term, but not to the next year
- ❖ Extra points earned cannot be exchanged for cash
- ❖ the FPP chair will send out a list of jobs and point values prior to each meet
