YOU MUST BE 48" TALL TO RIDE THE SLIDES AT THE CENTRAL UNIFIED AQUATICS COMPLEX

Open Swimming and Water Slides (recreation pool and slides only). Fees are general admission; swimming or not. Cash or check only. No credit cards accepted.

Opening Day: Saturday June 7, 2008 from 10:00 a.m. to 5:00 p.m. – Swim all day for \$3.00 on opening day!
Regular Schedule: Saturday 10:00 a.m. to 5:00 p.m.
Monday through Friday 10:00 a.m. to 8:00 p.m. starting **Monday, June 9, 2008**
Closed on Sundays.
(Closed for special events Friday through Sunday, June 20-22 and Thursday through Sunday, July 24 – 27, 2008)

Closing Date: Saturday, August 9, 2008

Admission Fees: \$6.00 all day pass including slides
\$4.50 all day pass without slides
\$5.00 after 3:00 p.m. with slides
\$3.50 after 3:00 p.m. without slides
\$50.00 (40.00 without slides) individual season pass (*Available from the Complex receptionist as of opening day, June 7, 2008*)
\$120.00 family season pass (3 people) \$25.00 for each additional immediate family member.

Swim Diapers: Tight fitting swim diapers are required for infants and toddlers who are not potty trained.

Party Rental Information (YOU MUST BE 48" TALL TO RIDE THE SLIDES AT THE CENTRAL UNIFIED AQUATICS COMPLEX)

The recreational pool and slides are available for party rentals. The entrance fee for groups of 10 or more is \$4.50 per person during normal recreation hours. You must submit a facility request form 5 days before your event to get this reduced rate. Late reservations will be accepted if there is availability at \$5.50 per person. ***We charge for all persons connected to your party; swimming or not.*** You will be assigned to a picnic area in the complex according to availability. Tables and chairs are loaned to parties ***if they are available. We do not guarantee availability of tables and chairs.*** If you wish to rent space in the facility outside of normal recreational hours, you must submit a facility request form and proof of liability insurance through your organization, (\$3,000,000.00 general liability) or your personal homeowner's policy (\$500,000.00 general liability). Central Unified School District must be named as an additional insured. You must also sign a CUSD hold harmless agreement. There is a minimum charge of \$90.00 per hour for lifeguards plus \$4.50 per person with a 30 person minimum (\$225.00 minimum party charge including guards) for groups requesting use of the recreation pool and slides outside of normal recreation hours. **If you wish to make reservations before our 2007 summer season begins, you must mail a completed facility request form and deposit to: Linda Torralva, 6155 W. TERMS & CONDITIONS

THESE PROVISIONS CANNOT BE DELETED

INSURANCE: Organization agrees to obtain at its sole expense and to provide evidence of liability insurance providing for minimum liability coverage of **\$3,000,000** for bodily injury and property damage arising from the use of District's facility. Such policy must provide coverage on an occurrence basis. Such liability insurance policy or policies shall name the DISTRICT, ITS OFFICERS, AGENTS, AND EMPLOYEES, INDIVIDUALLY AND COLLECTIVELY, AS ADDITIONAL INSURED WITH RESPECT TO ALL MATTERS RELATING TO OR ARISING OUT OF THIS AGREEMENT. Such coverage for additional insured shall apply as primary insurance. Any other insurance, or self-insurance, maintained by the District, its officers, agents and employees, individually and collectively, shall be excess only and non-contributing with insurance provided under Organization's policies. Organization's insurance shall not be canceled or changed without a minimum of thirty (30) days advance written notice given to the District.

LIABILITY*: If your organization is a recognized parent booster or scouting organization, by using the facility you agree to defend, indemnify and hold harmless the district, its board, officers, employees and agents from liability for any losses or injuries resulting from the negligence of the user group or any of its officers, employees, members or agents which may occur as a result of or during the use of the facilities. If you are an organization other than a parent booster or scouting organization, by using the facility you agree to defend, indemnify and hold harmless the district, its board, officers, employees and agents from liability for losses or injuries of any kind, that may result in any way from the organization's use of the facilities, regardless of cause. Organization will also be liable for any damage or destruction of school property and may be charged an amount equal to all damages and further use of facilities may be denied.

***If the organization is the University of California or California State University, or any sub-division thereof, then the foregoing paragraph shall be replaced by the following:**
Organization will be liable for injuries resulting from the use of the facilities or grounds and for all other resulting damages or injury in proportion to and to the extent such injuries or damages are caused by or result from the negligent acts or omissions of Organization, its officers, agents or employees. Organization hereby agrees to indemnify and hold harmless the District, its agents and employees, from all claims, actions, demands, liability, responsibility, damages, loss, cost and expenses of any nature whatsoever arising from Organization's use of the District facilities or grounds, including the cost of defending District, its agents and employees, against claims, actions or demands. Organization will also be liable for any destruction of school property caused by Organization and may be charged an amount equal to all damages and further use of facilities may be denied.

IMPROPER USE: Any use by an individual, society, group, or organization for the commission of any act intended to further any program or movement the purpose of which is to accomplish the overthrow of the government of the United States or of the state by force, violence, or other unlawful means shall not be permitted or suffered. By signing this agreement the undersigned agrees, to the best of his or her knowledge, that the school property for use of which application is hereby made will not be used for the commission of any act intended to further any program or movement the purpose of which is to accomplish the overthrow of the government of the United States by force, violence or other unlawful means; and that, the Organization on whose behalf he or she is making application for use of school property, does not, to the best of his or her knowledge, advocate the overthrow of the government of the United States or of the State of California by force, violence, or other unlawful means, and that, to the best of his or her knowledge, it is not a Communist action organization or Communist front organization required by law to be registered with the Attorney General of the United States. This statement is made under the penalties of perjury.

PROTECTION OF PROPERTY: School property must be protected from damage or mistreatment, and each third party user must be responsible for the condition in which it leaves the school facilities or grounds. In case school property is damaged, or must be cleaned as a result of such use, the same shall be paid for or reimbursed by Organization. Organization agrees to all terms and conditions above, and accept fees charged for facility use according to the District Fee Schedule. Information on fees is available at Central Unified Aquatics Complex. This Agreement is not effective until signed by the Authorized District Representative.
