Facility: Indoor 25-yard 6-lane pool. The competitions course has not been certified in accordance with 104.2.2C (4).

Timing: Colorado Timing System, plus shallow end timing buttons for 25's

Rules: Current USA Swimming and CSI Rules will govern the procedures of the meet. Age as of the first day of the meet will determine the age group. Meet is pre-seeded, timed finals. **For the Sunday sessions, all swimmers must report to the heating area prior to each swim in order to be heated for those swims.**

Eligibility: Open to all swimmers holding a 2009 USA Swimming membership card. Swimmers that appear on the CSI exception report for lack of registration must come to the meet prepared to show their card or they will be deck registered before they can enter the water. The normal registration fee plus a surcharge will also apply for deck registration, \$27.00 for year round and \$14.00 for seasonal. All deck entries from swimmers not already entered in the meet must present proof of current registration.

Entries: On line – www.boulderswimteam.org

Programs: Programs will be available for \$5.00.

Scoring: Cumulative time for all five (5) events will be used to determine finish order. All ties will be broken using points (19-17-16-15-14-13-12-11-10-9-8-7-6-5-4-3-2-1) and other criteria, if necessary.

Awards: Individual Trophies for the top 12 swimmers in each gender and age group. Swimmers must compete in all 5 events to qualify for an award. If a swimmer disqualifies, he/she will be assessed a time penalty as follows:

3 seconds for 25-yard event
4 seconds for 50-yard event
8 seconds for 100-yard event
12 seconds for 200-yard event

If the disqualification is determined by the Meet Referee to be intentional, the swimmer will be given the slowest time swum in that event. All disqualified swims will be reported to CSI as disqualifications, not as legal swims with the adjusted times.

A coach or team representative must pick up all awards in the meet office prior to leaving the pool on the final day of competition.

Results: Final results will be emailed to participating teams as soon as the database has been re-adjusted for all disqualifications.

Concessions: Full concessions will be available

Safety Issues:

With the exception of those lanes specifically identified as dive lanes, **all swimmers must enter warm-up lanes using a 3-point feet-first entry where both feet and one hand must be in contact with the deck or end wall immediately prior to entering the water.**

Marshals/Officials/Meet personal/Staff who observe swimmers to be in non-compliance will make every effort to contact/warn/remind said swimmer and/or his/her coach of the proper action. Consequences of non-compliance, if deemed to be repetitive, willful, or deliberately defiant by the observer, MAY include removal of the swimmer for the remainder of the session/competition and/or a \$500 fine to be paid by the athlete/coach/team/parent prior to said swimmer being allowed to compete in any future Colorado Swimming, Inc. sanctioned competition.

Warm-ups: Warm-up will be a split schedule and will be posted at the pool. The CUDA Internet site will list the start and warm-up times for teams by Wednesday, November 18th. Coaches will be responsible for monitoring their swimmers during the warm-up period. Starts may only be practiced with one way swimming. Following all CSI Warm-up Procedures is mandatory. One full hour has been scheduled for warm- up activity for the teams, but may be divided into two (2) thirty minute sessions at the discretion of the Meet Director and Meet Referee.
