AWARDS CRITERIA
2008-09 SEASON

1. EKSC Satellite Pools – Most Improved Awards (male and female)
 - Based on improvement of skill level and total improvement of time.
2. 10 & Under Awards (male and female)
 - Based on the addition of the highest scoring events for the 200 IM, 400 Free and next best event SC or LC (may not score in the same event for both SC and LC). The FINA Performance Rating Charts are used to score the performances.
3. 11 & 12 Awards (male and female)
 - Based on the addition of the 5 highest scoring events SC or LC (may not score in the same event for both SC and LC). The FINA Performance Rating Charts are used to score the performances.
4. 13 & 14 Awards (male and female)
 - Based on the addition of the 5 highest scoring events SC or LC (may not score in the same event for both SC and LC). The FINA Performance Rating Charts are used to score the performances.
5. 15 & 17 Awards (male and female)
 - Based on the addition of the 5 highest scoring events SC or LC (may not score in the same event for both SC and LC). The FINA Performance Rating Charts are used to score the performances.
6. Youth Top Swim Awards (male and female)
 - Based on the top LC performance for females aged 16 & under and males 17 & under as of Aug 31st, 2009. The FINA Performance Rating Charts are used to score the performances. Olympic events only.
7. Senior Top Swim Awards (male and female)
 - Based on the top LC performance as of Aug 31st, 2009. The FINA Performance Rating Charts are used to score the performances. Olympic events only.
8. University Swimmer of the Year Awards (male and female)
 - Based on total points scored at the CIS Championships, including relays at full value or results at the NCAA Division 1 Championships. Swimmers must be registered with EKSC and represent the club at National events.
9. Open Water Swimmer Awards (male and female)
 - Based on the highest international/national performance.
10. Swimmer with a Disability of the Year Awards (male and female)
 - Based on the highest international performance by a Swimmer with a disability.

11. Reagan Williams - EKSC High School Graduating Scholarship Award
 - Presented to a high school graduating swimmer(s) pursuing a post secondary education and representing EKSC.
12. Record Breaker Awards
 - Awards presented to swimmers breaking SC/LC Keyano Club, Swim Alberta, National Age Group, Senior National and World Records.
13. International Recognition Awards
 - Recognizes swimmers, coaches, officials, sport science/medicine staff and managers that attended international competitions and/or Games for the season.
14. International Relay Recognition Awards
 - Recognizes swimmers that competed on a National Team relay that earned a medal(s) at the World Student Games, Pan American Games, Commonwealth Games, Pan Pacific Championships, World Aquatic Championships or Olympic Games.
15. EKSC Service Award
 - Recognizes a volunteer(s) that has contributed, on an ongoing basis, to the overall success of the Edmonton Keyano Swim Club.
16. Stroke Performance Awards (male and female)
 - Based on the highest performing swim in an Olympic event LC for the following categories. The FINA Performance Rating Charts are used to score the performances.
 - Individual Medley
 - Breaststroke
 - Backstroke
 - Butterfly
 - Sprint Freestyle (50 & 100)
 - Middle Distance Freestyle (200 & 400)
 - Distance Freestyle (800 & 1500)
 - Performances must be at least a top 16 time at Senior Nationals or Trials to be eligible.
17. World Swimmer of the Year Awards (male and female)
 - Based on the top placing in an individual event at the Olympic Games, World Aquatic Championships, Pan Pacific Championships, Commonwealth Games, Pan American Games or World Student Games. Priority of performance will be based on the order of competitions listed previously. In case of a tie, the World rankings and/or the FINA Performance Rating Charts will be used to determine a winner.
