1. ELIGIBILITY

All swimmers currently registered with SNC are eligible. This is an open swim meet. No qualifying times are required. ***Coach's estimates are preferred to No Time entries.*** All current Swimming/Natation Canada rules will be followed.

2. AGE GROUPS

There will be FIVE age groups for the swimming of the events:
8 and under, 9–10, 11–12, 13–14, 15 and over

These age groups will be divided into EIGHT age groups for scoring:
8 and under, 9, 10, 11, 12, 13, 14, 15 and over

3. SEEDING

All events will be seeded from SLOWEST TO FASTEST except the 400 Free. All events will be TIMED FINALS. The 400 Freestyle and 400 Individual Medley will be senior seeded and separated for scoring.

4. STARTS

The FINA start rule will be in effect. ***The Referee will use every discretion for inexperienced swimmers.***

5. MEET RULES

This meet is sanctioned by Swim Alberta, abiding by the rules and regulations of Swimming/Natation Canada and FINA, contained in the SNC rule book (January 2006 Edition) and IPC unless otherwise stipulated in this meet package.

Please note: Anti-doping control will NOT be conducted during the competition; as a result, record setting performances will not be recognized by IPC Swimming. (Please refer to IPC Competition Approval Guidelines).

6. ENTRY LIMITS

Swimmers are limited to a MAXIMUM OF SEVEN (7) events, which are utilized for the determination of aggregate winners.

The 400 free may be swum with two swimmers per lane and only freestyle will be permitted. We will limit the event to 3 heats of girls (60 swimmers) and 2 heats of boys (40 swimmers). This event will be swum fastest to slowest and some entrants will be required to wear identifying swim caps.

At the discretion of the Meet Manager the 200 Free may also be double laned. Depending on the number of entries, the 400 I.M. may also have a maximum number of heats. (3 girl's heats / 2 boy's heats.)

The Meet is limited to 450 swimmers. Entries will be filled on a first come, first serve basis, based on the arrival time of the entry packages. The meet manager reserves the right to limit the number of swimmers from individual teams. The Meet Manager will use his discretion to expand this limit in striving to accommodate all swimmers from the same club in the last eligible entry.

7. ENTRIES AND ENTRY FEES

The entry fees are **\$5.75 per individual event**.

Entries are to be submitted on Hy-tek via the Swimming Canada website.

10. SCORING

Individual Events: 9, 7, 6, 5, 4, 3, 2, 1. There will be no team scoring.

11. AWARDS

Individual Awards: Medals for 1st, 2nd, and 3rd. Ribbons for 4th to 8th place.

Age Group Aggregate Award medallions will be awarded for the top three aggregate winners in each age group.

13. COACHES MEETING

There will be a coaches meeting on Saturday, November 14, 2009 at 1:30 p.m. in the equipment room on the south side of the pool deck at the Kinsmen Sports Centre.

14. SCRATCHES

Please submit scratches to the Clerk of the Course a minimum of 40 minutes prior to the start of each session. Late scratches will not eliminate the swimmer from subsequent events.

Refunds for scratches will only be made if received by November 6, 2009. Any scratches made after this date will not be refunded.

15. PROGRAM CHANGES

The Meet Manager reserves the right to alter, revise or otherwise modify the program to ensure the maximum number of swims in sessions of reasonable length, following receipt of entries.

Coaches will be advised of any changes prior to the start of the meet.
