5. E. Schwab, Registration and NTV Chair's Report: (ohioswim@cinci.rr.com)

-There is now a seasonal membership for swimmers (primarily useful for high school swimmers) which covers from Sept. 1 to Dec. 1. This is called Season II, and the cost is the same as the Season I membership (April 1 to August 1): \$27.

-If a swimmer was displaced due to the recent Hurricanes, the 120 day rule does not apply and the swimmer can compete immediately for his/her new team.

-There is NO registration on deck for any swimmers. If you fail to register a swimmer prior to a meet and Erin contacts you, you may register on-line, but Erin will not complete that registration until she receives the appropriate fee from you.

-When a swimmer transfers, Erin is now requiring a sign-off from that swimmer's previous team treasurer indicating that the swimmer has paid all dues owed to the previous club. Forms are available on the web.

6. Administrative Reports

a) C. Strunk, Administrative (cstrunk@bqnet.bgsu.edu):

b & c) D. Boettcher, Officials and NTV assistance (boettlnd@iac.net): His report:

We are continuing to roll out referee training to our officials. Also, we will complete a review of officiating integrity during the round of clinics this fall.

Our biggest challenge over the next few months will be to communicate the changes to the technical rules for backstroke and breaststroke that became effective 09/21/05. We will be covering the wording of the rule changes as well as interpretations and techniques for effective observation and judging.

Please note: While the backstroke rule does affect the placement of the toes (no longer must be under the water) at the start, it has no effect upon the requirement for a continuous turning action if the swimmer chooses to turn over to his breast to execute a turn. The butterfly kick which is now permitted at the start and the turns in the breaststroke must be executed during or

after the initial pull-out, and must be followed by a breaststroke kick. The cycle of stroke, kick, stroke, kick, etc., must be maintained.

In 2006 we will begin to implement a change to the current National and National Championship certification process. The current officiating levels (LSC, National, and National Championship) will become N1, N2, and N3. Certification to the N1 level will be the same as our current LSC requirements. The N2 and N3 certifications will require documented work at LSC level meets, endorsement by the LSC Officials Chair, and specific "higher level" meet experience. I will be getting more guidance at the Officials Chairs workshop in Omaha next week. Our Officials Committee will put a system in place next year.

Observed Meets - NTV

We have now had experience uploading observed meet data into the national database (SWIMS). The process is equivalent to the meet verification process for sanctioned USA-S meets. To insure that the data is timely and accurate, we will only upload times for swimmers who have USA-S ID numbers in the observed meet results summary. If a coach wants a verification/dB entry for a swimmer who did not have a USA-S ID number in the meet results, they must submit a written request form (available on the Ohio Swimming website) along with a fee of \$25/time requested. The NTV Handbook allows an LSC the flexibility to charge a fee for verification, if they desire. The objective here is to encourage swimmers/coaches to make sure they have an ID number entered in the meet package.

We will be asking our coordinators to communicate this to their NFHS, NCAA, and YMCA contacts.

This will also be incorporated into our LSC procedures, which are on the website.

d) B. Peaden, Top 16 Records (bpeaden@woh.rr.com): His report:

Ohio Short Course Records

Short course records from last winter season (2004-2005) are updated and posted to the OSI website. Many records are not accompanied by the "Records Application" that is in the Grey Book and posted to the OSI website, but we think we have got them all. It is very important that coaches & team reps submit the "Record Application" when an OHIO RECORD or an OHIO CHAMPIONSHIP MEET RECORD has been achieved. Once we are 12-24 months out from the current season, the chances of a record getting missed increases. **Note to the host of the 2006 Ohio SENIOR Championships:** please do a line-by-line comparison of the posted Ohio SENIOR Meet Records and the Ohio 15-18 Records to those in the meet backup from the 2005 meet to ensure the heat sheet has the accurate listing of records.

Ohio Long Course Records

Records will be posted to the OHIO SWIMMING website once the 15-18 age groups are complete. Tentative Date: 1-Nov-05

National "Top 16" Certificates

All athletes that are ranked 16th or faster in individual and relay events in the official SWIMS database at the conclusion of the season is awarded an award certificate from USA-Swimming.

USA-Swimming is moving to get the "Top 16" certificates to each LSC in a quicker turnaround (< 1 year) than in years past (> 1 year). The SWIMS database will allow this to happen. This is why it is important for coaches and team reps to verify their times in the USA-Swimming National database of times at <http://www.usaswimming.org>, click on "Times/Time Standards" and enter the appropriate filters.

SWIMS

All Ohio meets from summer 2005 has been loaded into the USA-Swimming database called SWIMS. All times can be viewed at www.usaswimming.org, select "Times/Time Standards" and select the appropriate filters for viewing.

SWIM CONNECTION

Club reps and coaches – encourage your swimmers & parents to logon and become a member of Swim Connection so they can get very cool reports immediately following a meet! (As long as OSI picks up the tab for Swim Connection, membership is free) Time standards for 2005-2006 have been sent to the programmers at Swim Connection on 9/27/05. They plan to have them integrated shortly. Coaches and team managers should know that Hy-Tek "result files" for every meet an Ohio swimmer attends, whether in-LSC or out-of-LSC, are always available at Ohio's "SWIM CONNECTION" within 24 hours after the conclusion of the meet, as long as you request and gain approval for "meet manager privileges" when you logon. Go to www.swimconnection.com/oh/ ...no more waiting around after a meet to get your results file!!

The following motions were made in order to streamline the championships meets:

-Motion to change Long Course AA meet to have all Prelim/Finals on Thursday, Friday and Saturday, with Sunday as an all-relay day, was withdrawn by Chip due to lack of support.

-Motion to make award presentations during the meet only in 10 and under timed final events was approved, effective immediately

-Motion to use the USA Swimming three part relay card was approved, effective immediately.

-Motion to use the national scratch rule for events of 400 meters or above was approved.

-Motion to limit entries in all age-group championship meets to only 9 events was approved, effective immediately.

-Motion to adopt the "Sidney Day Event Number System" (which begins the number of each event with the number of the day upon which it is swum) was approved, effective immediately.

-Motion to permit host clubs to require other teams to volunteer one timer per meet during prelim sessions was approved, effective immediately.

-Motion which only permits the swimmer to be entered with actual times in short course championship meets was approved, effective immediately.

-Motion which requires that all entry times must be **pre-proved** was approved, effective immediately. Swim Connections will be used by the Meet Entry Chair, and if a time is "kicked out" because there is no corresponding meet result, the coach will have 48 hours to prove that

the time was actually swum by the athlete or the athlete will be scratched from that event. All teams that are entered in the meet will receive a list of non-accepted swimmers so that each team knows whether or not there are any issues with their swimmers. This pre-proved requirement and consequences shall be posted in all age-group championship meet information.

-Motion to permit entries in LCM, SCM or SCY for long course championships, with seeding to follow the national guidelines, was approved.
