Learn to Swim with ASL

Our 'Splash' program is now 'Learn to Swim with ASL'!

The Learn to Swim Program is designed to provide a comprehensive program for beginning swimmers age 4-12. Our number one goal with the program is to provide a positive and enjoyable experience to beginning swimmers and have them gain confidence in their ability to swim. All swimmers need to be comfortable in the water, and will go through a structured program that is based on their skill levels. A swimmer who has fully progressed through the program would be ready to enter the full ASL program (begins with the White Group).

Each practice is conducted by trained instructors and is supervised by an ASL Coach. The student-instructor ratio is kept low to ensure the quality of each lesson.

Registration Details:

All swimmers **MUST** be registered through our online process **BEFORE** the session begins (www.swimasl.com). Online registration **WILL CLOSE** one week before the session is scheduled to begin. We will be unable to take registrations at the start of each session.

Fall Sessions:

Augusta Aquatic Center: Mondays/Wednesdays from 6:45-7:30 pm for 6 weeks beginning 9/20 and ending 10/27. Cost is \$150 for the 6 week session.

Riverwood Plantation: Saturdays from 8:30-9:15 am or 9:15-10:00 am for 8 weeks beginning 9/11 and ending 10/30. Cost is \$104 for the 8 week session.

USC-Aiken: Saturdays from 10:15-11:00 am for 8 weeks beginning 9/11 and ending 10/30. Cost is \$104 for the 8 week session.
