Terms and Conditions for Participation
Carpet Capital Aquatics Club 2008/2009

All families entering into the Carpet Capital Aquatics Club are members of our family. We would hope that when questions and concerns arise everyone involved would contact your primary coach for direct answers.

The **fees** involved in the Carpet Capital Aquatics Club are as follows:

1. Registration fee: This includes USA Swimming Annual Registration, team equipment, pool supplies and facility rental. This fee must be paid in full. \$150.00 per swimmer.

2. Monthly fees: These fees are based on your swimmer's group level and are listed on the fees schedule. **Monthly fees: Bronze \$55, Silver \$65, Gold \$70, Bullets \$75, PreSenior/Senior \$85.** These fees cover the expenses of the club operations. Monthly statements will be sent via e-mail on the 1st of each month. These must be paid by the 15th of the month. If your account is still outstanding by the first of the following month, your swimmer(s) may be asked to leave the water, and will not be allowed to participate in practice, meets or travel trips. A place is reserved for your swimmer. You are committing to join the Carpet Capital Aquatics Club for one year. Should a swimmer decide to discontinue participation with the Carpet Capital Aquatics Club the treasurer must be notified in writing thirty days in advance. Any outstanding fees are considered an obligation to the Carpet Capital Aquatics Club and are payable upon termination of participation. If your swimmer(s) take a temporary break from swimming the treasurer must be notified in writing thirty days in advance and an inactive fee of \$10 per month will be charged during that time. The inactive fee will not apply if the temporary break is due to illness or injury.

3. Meet fees: For each of the competitions your swimmer enters there will be fees for each event, including relays, in which they compete. Fees vary from meet to meet. These fees must be paid when entry form is submitted. Swimmers will not be entered without payment. A travel surcharge will be included on all meets not hosted by the Carpet Capital Aquatics Club. These fees help offset the costs of coaches travel to and from swim meets. Any meet within a 50 mile radius of Dalton High School will include a \$5 per swimmer surcharge. Any meet beyond the 50 mile radius that does not require flying, will include a \$10 per swimmer surcharge. Any meet that requires flying will

include a \$50 per swimmer surcharge. Any meet hosted by Carpet Capital Aquatics Club will include a \$5 per swimmer surcharge.

4. Misc. fees/charges: There may be other fees/charges which can be accessed throughout the course of the year (i.e. travel trip expenses, meet fines, etc). You will be notified in advance what these fees are and what they are for.

5. Swim Meet Obligation: The following conditions are part of your agreement to be a member of the Carpet Capital Aquatics Club:

It is the intent of the Carpet Capital Aquatics Club to host two meets annually. The meet schedule is included in this packet and the Carpet Capital Aquatics Club hosted meets are listed on this schedule. Please mark them on your calendar. These meets are fundraisers for the club to help cover the cost of operations throughout the year. They are an important part of our annual budget.

All families must work the meets hosted by Carpet Capital Aquatics Club. In general, these meets fall in December and April. Please take note that you may not have a swimmer competing in the meet, but are still required to work these meets. The meet sign-up forms will be online. They will go up one month to the day prior to the start of the upcoming meet. They will remain up for 2 weeks, and then will be taken down. THE MEET COMMITTEE WILL ESTABLISH THE NUMBER OF SESSIONS EACH FAMILY MUST WORK FOR EACH MEET.

At each meet there will be a registration table for you to "sign in" when you arrive at the pool. This table is generally located at the coach's desk on the pool deck. It is your responsibility to make sure that you have signed in properly. There will also be a "head person" at your station that should check you in.

If you are not able to work at one or more of the meets it is YOUR responsibility to find someone to work for you or pay the fine. You will be assessed a \$50.00 fine per session that is not worked.

If you sign up to work a session and fail to show up to work that session, you will be assessed \$100.00 per session. We do not want your money; we need your help during the meets!

Anyone working the meet to satisfy a work session must be in 9th grade or older.

USA Swimming regulations do not allow non-swimmers on deck at the meets. Please plan for childcare for your non-swimmers.

High School parents are not excluded from any of these expectations.

6. Fundraising Obligation: Revenue from fund raising and swim meets constitutes a significant part of the Carpet Capital Aquatics Club operating budget. **Each Carpet Capital Aquatics Club registered family is required to earn \$200 per year in fundraising credits to benefit the Club.** The annual period

during which this requirement is calculated is September 1, 2009 through August 31, 2010. We try to have four fund-raising opportunities annually. There will be a fund-raiser buy-out that will allow each family to pay \$150 directly to CCAC to fulfill their obligation. This is due by October 31st to be eligible. Please see the attached fund-raiser obligation form for more details.

Fundraiser Obligation Form - Carpet Capital Aquatics Club 2009-2010

This provides four opportunities during the annual period to meet your fundraising obligation. To ensure that each family meets their annual obligation we have two choices:

- 1) There will be a fund-raiser buy-out that will allow each family to pay \$150 directly to CCAC to fulfill their obligation. This is due by October 31st to be eligible.
- 2) A monthly fundraising assessment of \$16.50 will be added to your account and is due by the 15th of each month. Any funds earned at the above fundraisers will offset amounts previously charged and your account will be adjusted accordingly.
