Please note that polo players may come back into the pool area to call home after practice. Coaches will not leave the facility until all polo players have been picked-up.

Please be available, prompt and vigilant of the safety and well-being of your child during all practice and tournaments. Review with your child a safety plan for any unexpected circumstances.

Water Polo Players Responsibilities/Code of Conduct:

All water polo players representing Glenbrook Aquatics will conduct themselves in a manner that reflects positive credit to the individual and Glenbrook Aquatics club.

*No illegal use of drugs, alcohol, or tobacco will be allowed. **This is a NO tolerance rule!** This violation carries the potential of immediate expulsion and potentially longer-term consequences.

*No unlawful acts will be allowed.

*Water polo players must comply with the instructions of the coaching staff and listen to the best of their ability.

*Water polo players need to display good sportsmanship. Anyone displaying the following behaviors are subject to consequences listed below: 1) use of foul language 2) losing one's temper 3) yelling at coaches, teammates or parents 4) belittling anyone's effort 5) not listening to coach (s).

*No disruptive behavior during dry land training, stretching or pool time. Please be respectful of your coach and teammates. When someone is talking you are listening, this includes following the coaches direction and not distracting other swimmers.

*As a guest at a host facility, conduct will be subject to the rules and regulations of such host. This includes all Glenbrook District #225 facilities and any facilities of outside meets attended.

*Water polo players must pay for any and all damages due to misconduct and are subject to the consequences below as well.

*I will try my best to follow the above, be respectful and be on time for practices and tournaments. I understand and agree that should I break any of the rules or guidelines I will be subject to the consequences.

CONSEQUENCES:

- 1) The first occurrence will result a conversation between the swimmer and coach and a phone call made to the parent.
- 2) The second occurrence will result in the athlete being expelled from current workout or meet.
- 3) The third occurrence will result in swimmer being expelled from all club activities (including practices, meets, social events) for 7 days from the day of the third occurrence.
- 4) The fourth occurrence will result in the swimmer being expelled from the club for the remainder of the current season without refund.

Parent's Responsibilities/Code of Conduct:

Glenbrook Aquatics depends on the support and commitment of our water polo players parents. We recommend the following to enhance your experience as a Glenbrook Aquatics supportive parent. As a parent of a water polo player and member of Glenbrook Aquatics, I will abide by the following guidelines:

- *Practice teamwork with all parents, water polo players, and coaches by supporting the value of discipline, Loyalty, Commitment, and Hard Work.
- *Leave the coaching to the coaching staff. Do not coach or instruct the team or any water polo player at a practice or tournaments (from the stands or any other area) or interfere with the coaches while they are on the pool deck.
- *Demonstrate good sportsmanship by conducting myself in a manner that earns the respect of my child, other water polo players, parents, officials and the coaches at meets and practices.
- *Maintain self-control at all times and know my role as a swim parent.

- *During tournaments, questions or concerns regarding decisions made by meet officials are directed to a member of our coaching staff. Parents address officials via the coaching staff only.

Glenbrook Aquatics maintains the right to terminate any membership with/without cause in the interest of our mission, vision and objectives.
