THIRD ANNUAL TED MULLIN “Leave it in the Pool” HOUR OF POWER RELAY For Cancer Research

First held on November 7, 2006, the “Hour of Power” Relay included 15 teams that together raised \$11,000 to benefit the Ted Mullin Fund for Pediatric Sarcoma Research at the University of Chicago Comer Children’s Hospital. Last year, the number of participating teams climbed to 104, including 85 colleges and universities, two students-abroad teams and 17 high school and club teams, totaling nearly 6,000 athletes. Since 2006 the Hour of Power has raised over \$110,000 in support of sarcoma research.



This support has enabled the University of Chicago to recruit Stephen X. Skapek, M.D. as Director of Pediatric Oncology and a leader in translational sarcoma research. His expertise, leadership and work with collaborators aim to translate new scientific discovery into improved therapies for cancer patients like Ted Mullin.
