The Lancaster Aquatic Club (*LAC*) is a non-profit organization that offers a complete, year-round, competitive swimming program to Lancaster County, PA and its surrounding communities. The Lancaster Aquatic Club is a member of Middle Atlantic Swimming, and a sanctioned club within USA Swimming, the national governing body for swimming in the United States. Middle Atlantic Swimming includes teams from Pennsylvania, New Jersey and Delaware.

Our goal is to meet the needs of each individual swimmer, while developing a quality team based on ethics and hard work. Established in 1955, LAC was called the Lancaster YMCA Aquatic Club. Until 1965 the Club was made up of only female swimmers and competed in various venues, including the Susquehanna River! In 1966, Golden Meadows was built for the Lancaster Aquatic Club and the team continued to shine in the National spotlight with swimmers participating at the regional, national and Olympic levels over the years.
