MEET TYPE/QUALIFICATION: 2½-day "A/B+" meet for swimmers from all Minnesota zones, and swimmers from out-of-state. Prelim-Final for 11-12, 13-14 and 15/Older; Timed Final for 9-10 and 8/Under. **2009-2012** Minnesota Time Standards will be used. "B+" minimum entry standard is the halfway point between "B" and "A" standards; times are specifically listed in the Order of Events. All swimmers ("B+", "A" and faster) compete together for score/awards.

MSI ALL-ZONE MEET WEEKEND: The Team Foxjet Winter Classic is open to any USA Swimming (or FINA country member) athlete who possesses the qualification standard.

PURPOSE: To encourage and promote competitive swimming among age group and senior swimmers.

FACILITY: Two 8-lane, 25-yard indoor competition pools with lanes and backstroke pennants. Slanted starting blocks 26" above water surface; pool depths at the starting ends are 7' to 7'10". Separate warm-up facilities may be provided on a space-available basis (depending upon University schedule). **Both East and West competition pools will be utilized for Friday Evening Timed Finals, Saturday Prelims and Sunday Prelims.** The East competition pool (only) will be utilized for Saturday and Sunday afternoon Timed Finals and Saturday and Sunday Evening Finals.

MEET INFORMATION, RULES AND REGULATIONS: All information, rules and regulations, including time standards, schedules, orders of events and meet operations will be in accordance with Minnesota Swimming, Inc. competitive rules and regulations and USA Swimming Rules and Regulations current edition.

OVERSIZED MEET: If the meet becomes oversized according to Minnesota Swimming rules, the host club will implement Minnesota Swimming oversized meet procedures as required, and notify all participating teams appropriately.

WARM-UP & WATER ENTRY: Current MSI and USA Swimming Rules will govern all aspects of warm-up and competition. Swimmers and coaches are expected to be acquainted with all rules and obligations. Failure to follow will result in disqualification of swimmer(s) or coach(es) from next individual event or expulsion from the meet. The Minnesota Slip-In Entry and No Diving rules will be in effect in the separate warm-up and competition pools during warm-ups (except for designated sprint lanes) and will be strictly enforced. No horseplay will be permitted. Swimmers without a coach must report to the Meet Referee prior to warm-up for lane assignment.

SPLIT WARM-UP: Should athlete session/numbers require, and as per Minnesota Swimming legislation, the host club reserves the right to utilize split warm-up procedures (if necessary). If split warm-ups become necessary, all participating teams will be notified in advance of the meet. It should be noted that with two competition pools, plus the separate warm-up pool, it is unlikely that split warm-ups will be necessary.

TIMING SYSTEMS: Electronic timing system with backup buttons, stopwatches and horn start; touchpads at the starting end (or potentially both ends, depending upon availability) of the pools.

CODE OF CONDUCT: Sample enclosed must be signed and returned with team entries. Entries will not be accepted without a Code of Conduct signed by the parent of each athlete. 18/Older athletes may sign their own form.

AGE GROUP MEET: Age of swimmer determined by age as of January 15, 2010 (first day of the meet).

USA SWIMMING MEMBERSHIP: All swimmers must be 2010 Athlete Members of USA Swimming. All coaches must be current 2010 Non-Athlete (Coach) Members of USA Swimming and possess all current certifications as required to be a USA Swimming Coach. Any club or individual entering a non-USA Swimming registered swimmer will be subject to a \$25.00 fine per event per swimmer. Coaches will be asked to display credentials upon check-in and during all sessions of the meet. Other FINA member countries' (e.g. Canada) memberships are also accepted.

TIME STANDARDS/QUALIFICATION: 2009-2012 Minnesota Swimming Time Standards will be utilized. Minimum entry qualification of "B+" required for all individual events. "B+" times are halfway between the Minnesota "A" and "B" standards. Age groups of 8/Under, 9-10, 11-12, 13-14 Females, 13/Older Males and 15/Older Females will be utilized (with the exception of Friday evening, see note above). Standards for 13/Older Males are derived from 13-14; standards for 15/Older Females are derived from 15-16.

SEED TIMES/ENTRIES: All entry times must be submitted in **SHORT COURSE YARDS**. Non-conforming seed times and "NT" entries will NOT be accepted. Swimmers qualifying for this meet in long course meters should be entered at an estimated equivalent short course yards time which best represents their abilities.

ENTRY LIMITS: 11-12, 13-14 and 15/Older limited to three (3) individual events per day; 9-10 and 8/Under limited to four (4) individual events per day; relays do not count against individual event limits.

ENTRIES: Entries must be completed by the entering club or individual who will be solely responsible for the accuracy of the entry. E-mail entries are preferred. Please call the Entry Chairperson for directions if you need to hand-deliver.

Minnesota teams must use Hy-Tek or SDIF compatible software to run swim meets. Those teams using disk entry must use Hy-Tek or SDIF compatible software to enter this meet. There will be no disks sent out to clubs. Please include a printed and proofed copy of your COMMLINK REPORT, along with your disk, Code of Conduct, Fee Calculation Form and payment of fees (one consolidated check per club). Minnesota clubs entering this meet must use Hy-Tek or SDIF compatible disk entry unless your club is on record and approved by MSI that you cannot comply with the disk entry requirement. Clubs outside of the state of Minnesota may use Hy-Tek or SDIF compatible to enter this meet or may use the entry form included with this entry. All Swimmers must be members of USA Swimming and entered in the meet with their proper name and current 14-digit USA Swimming identification number.

ENTRIES MAY BE EMAILED to firemanmjr@att.net All teams are encouraged to utilize email. However, please note that emailed entries are in addition to, and do not replace, the normal entry procedure as stated above, which includes commlink hard copy report, fee calculation form, Code of Conduct and payment, which are due upon arrival/check-in at the meet. See note below.

EMAIL ENTRY NOTE: When you e-mail your entries, also attach your Commlink Report and Fee Calculation Form. **PLEASE NOTE: If you do not receive an e-mail confirmation within 24 hours, your entries were not received.** If entry is sent via email, all forms and payment may simply be brought to the meet and submitted upon check-in. This is for your convenience and prevents writing multiple entry checks for one meet. However, no teams or athletes will be permitted to participate until all forms and payment are received. This makes check-in at the meet very important! All coaches/teams must check-in to ensure proper entry.

ENTRIES DUE: 6:00 PM, Friday, January 8, 2010

LATE QUALIFICATION: Swimmers/teams qualifying for this meet after the entry deadline must submit their entries prior to 2:00 PM on Monday, January 11th. These entries may be emailed, hand-delivered or telephoned to the Meet Entry Chairperson. No entries will be accepted after the 2:00 PM deadline. No changes/deletions to existing entries will be accepted. Only additions to the original entry will be accepted. Faster times/upgrades will NOT be accepted.

FEES: \$2.50 MSI Fee per swimmer (including "relay only" swimmers), \$5.00 per individual splash, \$20.00 per relay. Summarize costs per calculation sheet. Checks must accompany entries and made payable to: **TEAM FOXJET**

MEET CHECK IN: Meet check-in will take place between 4:00pm and 5:00pm on Friday afternoon. A coaches table will be positioned near the scorers table. The Entry Chair will accept all required entry information and advise coaches on the use of the Coaches Box that will be used to pass on relevant information during the meet. Coaches not attending Friday Evening Sessions should contact Entry Chair upon their arrival at the pool.

OPEN LANE SWIMS: The MSI Open Lane Swim procedure will be utilized. The splash fee is \$5.00. Sign-up is on a space-available basis with the Entry Chair. Swimmers must already be registered in the meet in order to participate in Open Lane swims. Swimmers may not exceed their daily event limit, including Open Lane swims. Swimmers may scratch an event in order to swim an Open Lane swim (to stay within the entry limit), but no refunds will be given for scratched events.

MEET FORMAT: Friday Evening Timed Finals for all events, run fastest to slowest, **POSITIVE CHECK-IN, DECK SEEDED**; both competition pools will be utilized. Saturday and Sunday Prelim-Final for 11-12, 13-14 and 15/Older, both competition pools will be utilized. East competition pool (only) will be utilized for Evening Finals. Saturday and Sunday Afternoon Timed Finals for 9-10 and 8/Under; East competition (only) will be utilized. All swimmers report directly to their blocks. 9-10 200 Free and 200 IM are **POSITIVE CHECK** by 2:00pm each day, **DECK SEEDED**, swum fastest to slowest. 13/Older 500 Freestyles are Timed Final, **POSITIVE CHECK-IN** and **DECK SEEDED**, with the fastest eight seeded directly into Finals. The Minnesota Scratch Rule will be in effect.

Minnesota 5 Hour Rule: Upon the completion of all entries, it will be determined if any session in either pool is over 5 hours in length. If it is determined that there are sessions that are longer than 5 hours the Meet Referee will determine which events within that session will be required to be **POSITIVE CHECK-IN**. When teams check-in they will be notified as to which events will require **POSITIVE CHECK-IN**. Upon completion of the **POSITIVE CHECK-IN**, it will be determined if any of those events will require **RE-SEEDING**. Teams will be notified which events have been **RE-SEEDING** and new coaches programs will be distributed. If it is determined that there will be no significant time savings, the events will be swum as originally listed.

FRIDAY TIMED FINALS: All Friday evening events are Timed Final, positive check-in and deck-seeded. With the exception of the 11-12 age group, all Friday evening events are swum together as 13/Older for score and awards, utilizing the 13-14 time standards. Check-in with the Entry Chair is required by 5:00 PM. All Friday events will be swum fastest to slowest, in both competition pools. Friday evening events' psych sheets will be posted on the Team Foxjet website by Wednesday, January 13th at <http://teamfoxjet.com> for an advanced look at these events.

Saturday 9-10 200 IM & Sunday 9-10 200 FREE: These 9-10 events are Timed Final, deck-seeded, with positive check-in with the Entry Chair required by 2:00 PM. These events will be swum fastest to slowest, at the end of the afternoon sessions (after the relays). There will be a break after the relays to provide adequate rest. The Minnesota Scratch Rule will be in effect.

RELAYS: All teams entered in the meet are permitted at least one relay entry per relay event, regardless of swimmers' times, provided that all relay teams meet the following criteria:

1. All swimmers must be attached, registered members of their team. No unattached swimmers may participate.
2. All swimmers must be entered in an individual event, or entered as a "Relay Only" or "Relay Alternate" swimmer.
3. Teams may enter more than one relay in a relay event only if the number of swimmers they have participating in individual events in that age group exceeds the number of swimmers in increments of four needed to field a relay (4 or less swimmers = 1 relay, 5 swimmers = 2 relays, 9 swimmers = 3 relays, and so forth).

Teams that submit relays entries with names will have those names appear on their relay card(s) when the cards are distributed at the meet. Teams are encouraged to utilize this method, which can hasten relay card submission on deck.

ALL RELAYS ARE TIMED FINAL. ALL HEATS OF 11-12 AND 13/OLDER RELAYS WILL BE SWUM DURING THE MORNING PRELIMINARIES.

CLERK OF COURSE: The **Top 8** 11-12, **Top 16** 13-14 and **Top 16** 15/Older qualifiers in each Prelim-Final event will advance to Evening Finals; the fastest eight swim in the Championship heat; the second fastest eight swim in the Consolation heat. The exception to this format is the Finals for the 13&Over Males; they will be swum as a 13-14 Championship heat and a 15&Over Championship heat. Places 9 through 16 will be scored from preliminaries. The Minnesota Scratch Rule will be in effect. All swimmers report directly to their blocks.

SCORING: All events scored to sixteen places. Individual Events: 20-17-16-15-14-13-12-11-9-7-6-5-4-3-2-1. Relay events: 40-34-32-30-28-26-24-22-18-14-12-10-8-6-4-2.

AWARDS: All swimmers ("B+" and "A" and faster) compete together for score/awards. Individual events 1st-8th place medals, relays 1st-3rd place medals. Individual High Point Awards (Top 3) for swimmers in each age group and gender. Team Plaques will be awarded for 1st-3rd place teams in each Division (AAA, AA, A). Non-Minnesota clubs will be placed in the AAA Division. The host team is ineligible for team awards. Awards will be given out to athletes 30 minutes after posting of the final results, barring complications with the results.

TIMELINES: Any timeline provided, whether through the MSI phone line, website or meet program, is for informational purposes only and subject to change as the meet progresses.

COACHES' MEETINGS: Will take place on a regular basis at the discretion of the Referee. Meetings will not take place during warm-up (or competition) unless a serious issue warrants immediate discussion.

CHANGES TO MEET INFORMATION: Any proposed changes to the meet information will be discussed at the coaches meeting(s), and require a 100% affirmative vote for approval by all teams represented at the meeting.

FINAL RESULTS: Each team's final results will be emailed the following day, January 18th. If results are needed in a special format, contact the Entry Chair. A complete hard copy result will be offered for \$10.00, and will be mailed the following week to the destination indicated on the Fee Calculation Sheet.

OFFICIALS SPECIAL NOTE: Team Foxjet always welcomes help with officiating from participating clubs. Please make this offer known among all parents. Parents who are certified officials, need an apprentice session, or just wish to participate for love of the sport, please make your availability known in advance to the Entry Chairperson.

CONCESSIONS, MEMORABILIA, PROGRAMS, EQUIPMENT: Will be on sale during each session.

ADDITIONAL INFORMATION: No spectators are permitted on the pool deck or in adjacent competition-related spaces. No street shoes allowed on the pool deck. Coaches, swimmers, officials and volunteers are requested to wear tennis shoes. No glass or other breakables are permitted anywhere in the Aquatic Center.

OFFICIALS CERTIFICATION

This meet will be designated as a "Qualifying Meet," and a "National Evaluator" will be in attendance for certification and re-certification evaluations. Those desiring initial certification or re-certification above the LSC level should download the new application for this purpose from the "*Officials*" section under the "*Volunteers*" tab on the USA Swimming web site. There will be opportunities at the meet to be evaluated for N2 -level positions. However, there may not be enough resources to accommodate all such requests. All applications for evaluations should be e-mailed to the meet referee, Michael Bougie at michael.bougie@unisys.com.
