



## Brandeis University Pool Access Instructions

The main address of Brandeis University is 415 South St in Waltham.

### SITE DIRECTIONS:

Upon entering the main athletics drive on South Street, proceed straight down the hill and wind to the left behind the Gosman Athletic Center. On the back side of the building, continue straight to the end of the building (tennis courts on right) and take a left. Drive up the incline and take the first right just after the big red dumpster (do not drive straight up the hill under the glassed footbridge, it is a fire lane!). The building now on your left is the Linsey pool.

Park in the lot adjacent to the back of the pool building. If there are no spaces remaining, continue out of this lot to the right and down the hill (student housing on left) and park in the larger lot you spill into. This lot will be adjacent to the tennis courts.

**NOTE:** Once you drive past the red dumpster, the road between the pool and the parking lot becomes a one way road. Cars should only exit the parking lot behind the pool by taking a right.

All swimmers, coaches, and parents should walk up the fire lane (under the glassed in footbridge) to the stairs on the right hand side, These stairs lead to the front of Linsey pool where you can enter the pool via the main glass entrance doors. There is a Brandeis lifeguard stationed at the desk monitoring building access. *Do not attempt to access the pool via the handicapped ramp or the emergency exit door that is at the top of the metal stair case on the back of the building. Brandeis does not want dirt and sand on the pool deck. All swimmers and coaches should exit via the main entrance at the end of the meet as well.*

Once inside the main lobby, the girl's locker room is down one flight on the immediate left and the boy's locker room is down one floor on the immediate right. Per USA-S policy, parents are not allowed on the pool deck at a meet. Only registered coaches and officials will be allowed on deck.

Parents/guardians can continue straight from the main entrance to the seating area. There are restrooms in the hallway for non-swimmers.

### Important Notes:

**There is to be no stopping, parking, or general drop off/pick up activities on South Street. This is a busy street and there is no practical place to stop or pull over.**

**No person involved with the meet should not be in any other part of the building other than the locker rooms, the pool deck, and the stands. This includes any of the multipurpose rooms and the front desk in the lobby. There is wireless access available in the pool.**
