Position: The South Shore YMCA Strypers is looking for suitably qualified, experienced and passionate candidates to fill the position of an Assistant Swim Coach. This part-time position reports directly to the Head Coach.

Background: The South Shore YMCA Strypers (SSYS) is a former Silver Medal club under USA Swimming's National Club excellence program. Under the new leadership of Australian ASCA Level 5 Head Coach Tim Mulvihill, SSYS provides a program that reinforces the four core values of Caring, Honesty, Respect and Responsibility and to develop the individual in a competitive team environment to be successful in swimming and in life.

The Strypers Swim Team exists to:

- Advance the sport of swimming and produce national caliber athletes on a consistent basis by providing every athlete that will allow him or her to systematically progress from the novice to the elite levels of competition.
- Recruit individuals (coaches, swimmers and families) who share our vision.

- Have been personally involved in competitive swimming, preferably at the collegiate level.
- Be a current registered member of USA swimming and the American Swim Coaches Association (ASCA).
- Be certified at ASCA Level Two or have the ability to achieve certification with one year of hire.
- Ability to be flexible and work “swim team” days and hours.
- Possess Lifeguarding, CPR and First Aid certifications.

*** The position will also be contingent on a successful CORI/SORI background check.*

Remuneration: The successful candidate will be placed appropriately on the SSYS coaching pay scale. An hourly rate will be established based on prior experience and education.
