FACILITIES: 8 lane, 50m pool with non-turbulent lane lines, controlled temperatures, Colorado Timing System, large scoreboard, spectator seating upstairs, and athlete rest areas. Adjacent lap pool available for continuous warm-up and warm-down.

Facility Certification: The venue has been measured and certified in accordance with USA-S 104.4.2C (4). The copy of such certification is on file with USA-Swimming. The water depth of the competition pool when measured for a distance of $3'3 \frac{1}{2}$ " (1.0 meter) to 16'5" (5.0 meter) from the start end wall is 13' 6" and when measured for a distance of 3' $3 \frac{1}{2}$ " (1.0 meter) to 16' 5" (5.0 meter) from the turn end wall is 7' 4". USA-S Rule 202.4.9 (C).

TEAMS: King Marlin Swim Club, North Texas Nadadores and Academy of Texas Aquatic Champions (un-attached swimmers, affiliated with these teams are also eligible to enter this event.)).

WARM-UP: There will be two warm-up sessions. Team lane assignments will be posted at the pool prior to the start of warm-ups. Warm-ups will start at 9:00 am for the host team. Visiting teams will begin warm ups at 9:30 am. There will be dive starts for all teams from 10:00am- 10:15am. Oklahoma Swimming Warm Up guidelines shall be posted at the venue. The meet will begin at 10:30 am.

Eligibility: The Meet Director will insure that an athlete registration re-con report is instituted by Monday, April 18th, 2016. The Meet Director shall notify each attending team of any registration errors within 2 days of the start of the meet. The Meet Director shall insure that all athlete entry registration errors are reconciled prior to the start of the first session of competition. Any athlete lacking complete registration verification will be prohibited from competition until such registration is corrected. No swimmer will be permitted to compete unless the swimmer is a member as provided in Article 302. 202.4.9 \in Registration with USA-S/Oklahoma Swimming will not be accepted at this event. 202.4.9 (F). Deck entries will not be accepted at this meet. Any swimmer entered in the meet must be certified by a USA-S member-coach as being proficient in performing a racing start or must start each race from within the water. When unaccompanied by a member coach, it is the responsibility of the swimmer or the swimmers legal guardian to ensure compliance with this requirement. 202.4.9 (D). AWARDS: No awards will be given.

SCORING: For the purposes of team scoring individual events will be scored as follows: By age groups: 8 and under, 9-10, 11-12, 13-14, and 15 and over. Points awarded: 1st-9 pts, 2nd-7 pts, 3rd-6 pts, 4th-5 pts, 5th-4 pts, 6th-3 pts, 7th-2 pts, 8th-1 pt. Relays doubled: 1st-18 pts, 2nd-14 pts, 3rd-12 pts, 4th-10 pts, 5th-8 pts, 6th-6 pts, 7th-4 pts, 8th-2 pts. Relays scored: 8 & under, 9 – 10, 11 -12, 13- 14, 15 and over.

RESULTS: Complete Team Manager Results, A Read only MM BK up, and Resluts in publication format PDF report will be sent to each team's entry representative no later than 24 hours after the conclusion of the meet. The Meet Director will at the same time send to the OKS Swims Chair results for SWIMS from the event.

ENTRY LIMITS: Individual swimmers may enter a maximum of 4 individual events for the meet. Each swimmer may ONLY swim ONE distance per stroke. (i.e. cannot enter the 50 fly and 100 fly.) Athletes may enter in 1 relay maximum for the meet. Deck entries will not be accepted.

ENTRIES: An entry file will be sent to all teams prior to the entry deadline. Each team shall send to the MEET DIRECTOR at <u>swimmeets@att.net</u> a HY-TEK entry file with complete team entries by the entry deadline (6:00 pm Saturday April 16, 2016).. A contact name, e-mail address and phone number of the appropriate entry person from each team is required. Only Long Course times will be accepted. Send all electronic entry information to: Tracey Garrett at <u>swimmeets@att.net</u>. Entry fee payment should be made out to KMSC and brought to the meet.

ENTRY DEADLINE: Entries must be received no later than 6:00 pm Saturday, April 16th, 2016.

ENTRY FEES: The entry fee for teams will be a flat fee of \$20.00 per athlete. This fee covers the Oklahoma Swimming splash fee of \$2.00 per event per athlete for 4 individual events and 1 relay. Each team should make one check payable to KMSC for all entries. No individual checks will be accepted; only one check from each club. Payment of entry fees may be made at the meet.

Swimmers with Disabilities: Coaches and or swimmers are responsible for notifying the Meet Referee or Meet Director of any disability prior to the competition and for providing their own assistant or equipment. Please contact the Meet Director/ Meet Referee at least 2 weeks in advance of the meet to reserve proper equipment.

Rules: The current USA Swimming, Inc. rules and regulations will apply. Oklahoma Swimming safety guidelines and warm-up procedures will be in effect at this meet. The use of audio or visual recording devices including a cell phone, is not permitted in changing areas, rest rooms or locker rooms. 202.4 .9(H). Changing in or out of swimsuits other than in locker rooms or other designated areas is prohibited. 202.4.9(I). Parents and other spectators must remain in the bleachers above the pool. OKS prohibits the use of all devices capable of taking photographs (e.g. cameras, cell phones, PDA, I Pads etc.) from behind the starting blocks during all meets sanctioned by Oklahoma Swimming. Use of these devices will not be permitted during warm-up or competition sessions. Any individual requiring deck access for photographic purposes must notify the Meet Director before gaining access to the deck. Children not participating in the meet must be supervised at all times by an adult and are not allowed on the pool deck for any reason. The Meet Director and Meet Referee reserve the right to limit deck access in the event of overcrowding, inappropriate behavior or for any reason concerning the safety or the efficient operation of the meet. USA-S Rules of Conduct will be strictly enforced. USA-S Non Athlete registration cards do not grant access to the deck.

Sanction and Liability: This meet is held under the sanction of USA Swimming, Inc. by Oklahoma Swimming. Sanction # OK16-027. "IN GRANTING THIS SANCTION AND BY ANY PERSON'S PARTICIPATION IN THE MEET IT IS UNDERSTOOD AND AGREED THAT USA SWIMMING, INC., OKLAHOMA SWIMMING, INC., ALL MEET OFFICIALS, VOLUNTEERS OF THE HOST ORGANIZATION KMSC, MITCH PARK YMCA/EDMOND PUBLIC SCHOOLS AQUATIC CENTER SHALL BE FREE FROM ANY AND ALL LIABILITIES OR ANY CLAIMS FOR ANY DAMAGES, ARISING BY REASON OF INJURIES TO ANYONE DURING THE CONDUCT OF THE MEET. EVEN IF SUCH LIABILITIES OR CLAIMS ARE DUE TO THE NEGLIGENCE OF SUCH ORGANIZATIONS. Damage to a facility, when proven, will cause the offending swimmer or swimmers, if unattached, or the offending swimmer's club, if attached, to be held accountable for repairs.

Seeding: This will be a pre-seeded meet, fastest to slowest. All times must be received in LCM.

HOSPITALITY: A limited hospitality will be available for Coaches and Officials working the meet.
