

Training Sites and Facilities

The Cincinnati Marlins operate at four locations: Marlins Central, our long-time home and largest facility, at Keating Natatorium on the campus of St. Xavier High School, Marlins South at Scott High School in Taylor Mill, KY, Marlins West at Taylor High School in North Bend, OH and Marlins North at Princeton High School in Sharonville, OH. Our sites provide a wide range of training groups, lessons, clinics and introductory programs. Our goal is to provide convenient training locations and times with outstanding coaching and instruction for swimmers throughout Greater Cincinnati.

Keating Natatorium is the original home of the Marlins, our largest training facility and the team's headquarters. Keating is the site of almost all Marlins-hosted meets. Built by the Marlins in 1968, it was one of only four long-course indoor pools in the United States. The pool is 50 meters X 8 lanes and can be divided into two 25-yard, 8 – lane pools through the use of a bulkhead system. The bulkhead is one-of-a-kind providing a flow-through design for reduced water turbulence. From the start, Keating has been known as a fast pool, hosting National, State, Sectional, Senior, Junior Olympic and Zone Championships. In 2000, a major renovation of the facility was completed. The pool features underwater observation windows, a full-service concession area and kitchen, a meet office, staff and coach's offices, meeting rooms, locker rooms, hospitality and official's rooms, weight room and seating for 1000 spectators. The lobby and entry area is the home of the Cincinnati Marlins Hall of Fame, honoring our athletes who have represented the United States in international competition.

Keating is equipped with a Colorado Display Systems 8' X 15' Olympex Scoreboard. This display is a full color, video-capable LED matrix display. Our Colorado Timing System features Series 6000 scoring consoles with Colorado touch pads and electronic relay judging platforms with speed lights. The facility is managed by the Marlins and is also the home of the St. Xavier Aqua Bombers, one of the nation's leading high school swim teams.

**Cincinnati Marlins North location
Princeton High School Natatorium**



The natatorium is a 6 – lane, 25 yard facility with seating for 300 spectators. The Marlins manage this facility for our program and for the Princeton High School swimming and water polo teams.

**Cincinnati Marlins South location
Scott High School**



The Scott High School facility is a six-lane, 25-yard pool with seating for 300 spectators. The pool is also used by high school teams from Scott High School, Dixie Heights High School and Simon Kenton High School.

The Taylor High School natatorium is a five-lane, 25-yard facility which we share with the Taylor High School Yellowjackets.
