**Licking County Family YMCA Swim Team**  
**Escrow Accounts**

Swim Families,

As members of the LCFY Sharks swim team, entry fees will be incurred for swimming events at many of the scheduled meets (YMCA Invitationals and USA meets). Every family is encouraged to have an escrow account if your swimmer(s) will participate in these meets. An Escrow Account is simply a deposit account used exclusively to pay a swimmer’s event entry fees throughout the season.

You may deposit funds to your account at anytime throughout the season with the Parent Club Treasurer(s). When your swimmer(s) registers for a meet, the Parent Club Treasurer will deduct the entry fees from your escrow account. Periodic Escrow Account statements will be emailed to your preferred address to provide an accounting of your Escrow Deposit Account.


A **minimum** recommended initial deposit amount for **each** swimmer is:

Swimming only YMCA meets . . . . .	\$40
Swimming YMCA and USA meets . . . . .	\$80

When this amount is depleted, you should make an additional deposit to your escrow account to cover upcoming meets. It is a team requirement that your swimmer(s) entry fees for all meets be paid prior to or at the time of signing up for a meet. Using the escrow account is a simple and easy way to do this. Any unused amount can be rolled over to the next season or returned upon request.

To participate simply:

STEP 1      DECIDE AMOUNT

STEP 2      WRITE CHECK  Payable to: LCFY Sharks Parents Club  
 Include swimmer(s) name in the memo line

STEP 3      DROP IN SWIMMING LOCK BOX – located to the left of the bulletin boards in the swimming pool lobby. The funds will then be entered into your escrow account.
