## Driving to the Aquatic Pavilion

Construction on SR-315 has closed many of the exits generally used to get to campus. The 315 project, along with some campus upgrades have limited some of our most used driving routes. Be sure to review the routes recommended below to ensure a smoother commute to the Aquatic Pavilion. Travel times may be increase this summer, so please keep this in mind when making your travel plans.

**From the East (Airport)** - Take I-670 West to the Neil Avenue Exit. Turn right onto Neil Ave. off of the exit and follow all the way until you come to the Main Library. Turn left before the Library and the McCorkle Aquatic Pavilion is directly ahead. Parking is available in the Neil Avenue Garage just ahead on the left.\*

\*If the Neil Ave Garage is full, parking is available in the Tuttle Park Garage with additional hourly parking available on the right in the Ohio Stadium lots. Note: Ohio Stadium lots require Pay-n-Park sticker that can be purchased in the lots. Look for the blue Pay-n-Park machines.

**To Tuttle Park Garage from Neil Ave Garage** : Take a right on Neil Ave, followed by a left on 12<sup>th</sup> Ave. Take a left on College Rd. Turn left on W. Woodruff Ave, and left again on Tuttle Park Pl. The parking garage will be on your left. Follow Tuttle Park Pl. toward Ohio Stadium and the red walkway to reach McCorkle Aquatic Pavilion.

It is the expectation of the McCorkle Aquatic Pavilion event staff that these are the routes available during our summer event season (through July 19); however routes changes are out of our control and are may change without notice.

## Other Meet Information:

Racing for 25 yard events will start on the bulkhead and race toward the diving well. The starting blocks on the bulkhead will also provide a starting platform for the 100 yard relay races. The bulkhead is off limits during the day, except for officials and the bullpen workers to help the swimmers on the 25 yard races. There WILL be blocks on the bulkhead for the 25s and the 100 yard relays.

The afternoon session (only) will utilize fly-over starts. For individual events (except backstroke), swimmers will need to remain in the pool near the lane line, until the upcoming heat takes off of the blocks.

There will be a bullpen for individual events for Saturday morning (the East side of the pool, opposite from the hospitality room).

Swimmers, please help maintain quiet for the starts and do not loiter behind the blocks. The biggest challenge is for relays. Swimmers should remain in another area until they are 3 races (not events) away from their relay turn to swim.

There will be no flash photography at the start of a race. As you all know, a flash at the wrong time may cause a false start and a swimmer's disqualification, so it is very important everyone abides by this rule.

OSU is supplying stop watches for volunteer timers

There will be positive check-in for the 1000 free and the 1650 free (near the scorers table).

Our team will be assigned a lane for warm-up, which will be communicated to the coaches the day of the meet. Swimmers, when not doing starts, remember that the requirement is feet first entry for safety! Remember – SAFETY FIRST!

Deck passes are required for adults to be on deck. If you signed up to work the Awards Room or to time, your deck pass will be distributed to you prior to your assigned time. Please see Kelly Fenimore for deck passes for the AM session, and Cathy Untied for deck passes for the PM session. If you signed-up to officiate, you should report at 40 minutes prior to the start of each session's start. You will be able to pick up your deck pass directly from the Ross County representative in the Lobby Area of the pool.

Swimmers, remember that USA Rules require swimmers to touch the pad in your lane to finish the race.

Please remember to clean-up our area on the pool deck before departing, especially at the end of the first session. There will not be time for OSU to clean the deck between sessions. Also remember that the locker rooms are not a playground. RESPECT the facilities!
