

## Officials Clinics

The swim team is always looking for more people to volunteer to be stroke and turn officials during the swim meets. As such, there are several clinics scheduled in the next few months. If you are interested in becoming a new stroke and turn official, the Level I clinics being offered are on the dates below. Prior to registering for one of the clinics, a registration form must be completed and approved by the YMCA. If you are new to year-round swimming with YOSI, the team suggests that interested individuals volunteer to be timers during the swim meets for the first year in order to observe the stroke and turn officials on deck before committing to becoming a stroke and turn official.
