Do not mail entries to the Pool!

Eligibility: Swimmers must be currently registered with USA Swimming. NO ON DECK REGISTRATION WILL BE PERMITTED. Swimmers must be within the listed age brackets as of April 3rd, 2010. *Remember, this is a **B/C** meet, so if your swimmers have an A time in their age bracket they cannot enter that event in the open class. Please be honest with entry times. A certified USA/OSI Swim Coach must supervise all swimmers.*

Entry Deadline: Entries must be received by March 26th, 6 p.m.

Entry Limit: Swimmers may enter a maximum of five individual events and one relay. Meet is limited to the first 225 swimmers. **NO LATE ENTRIES OR CHANGES WILL BE ACCEPTED!** This is a MIXED sex seeded event.

Entry Process: Your team has been invited to a closed meet. This is an Invitational and only teams on this list are invited. Your entries will be accepted on a first come first serve basis. When we reach the 225-swimmer limit, we are closed. Please get everyone entered on your original entry. If after the meet is seeded and we are over the time limit, then each team will be given the chance to scratch down to help bring the meet under the time line. If we do not achieve that, then the meet management will bring the meet into compliance with the 4-hour rule.

Entry Fees: \$3.00 Oregon Swimming surcharge per swimmer
\$2.00 individual event fee
\$8.00 relay entry fee

Entry fees must accompany master entry form or disk. Make checks payable to: Woodburn Barracuda Swim Team (or WBST). Checks must arrive by March 26th for entries to be submitted. Entries are not official till the check arrives. Only one check per team.

- Entries: Submit YARD TIMES only for seeding. Hy-tek Meet Manager Software will be used; if your club has Hy-tek PLEASE submit entries on disk and provide a Hy-tek printout. (In addition to mailing the disk **you can email it to** coachzell@wbst.org for faster processing.) If you do not have Hy-tek, entries must be submitted using the enclosed entry forms ONLY. Entries are not officially received till the check arrives.
- Relays: Enter relay times on the form provided if not using Hy-Tek. Names for relays will be submitted on relay entry forms provided at the meet or can be submitted on Hy-tek disk.
- Facility: Indoor 25 yard pool with 8 lanes. Starting blocks at the deep end of the pool only. Depth at starting end is 6'; shallow end is 3'6". Limited parking available, seating for 200 spectators. Swim venue includes: Men and Women's locker rooms with access onto the pool deck.
- Restrictions: TOBACCO PRODUCTS OF ANY KIND, ALCOHOLIC BEVERAGES AND GLASS CONTAINERS ARE NOT ALLOWED IN THE SWIMMING VENUE.
- Times: Warm-ups: 7:45 a.m. – 8:45 a.m. (Pool doors open at 7:30 a.m.)
Start Time: 9:00 a.m.
End time: 1:00 p.m.
- Rules: Current USA Swimming and Oregon Swimming, Inc. rules will govern this meet.
- Safety: Current Oregon Swimming Safety Guidelines and Warm-up Procedures will be in effect and strictly enforced.
- Bull Pen: A bullpen will be provided for all 8 & under swimmers. All other swimmers shall report directly to their assigned lanes. **8 & unders will start in shallow end of pool for 25's.**
- Awards: Individual: 1st – 6th Ribbons 6&U, 7-8, 9-10, 11-12, 13&O
Relays: No Awards
Those achieving "A" times will receive an "A" certificate and will not score points or receive awards.
- Meeting: Coaches' meeting will be held at 8:45 am. Officials meeting will be held from 8:00 – 8:45 a.m. Please allow 30 minutes for Officials meeting. All Coaches and Officials must posses and display current credentials for certification as Coaches or Officials. Coaches or Officials without current credentials will not be allowed on the pool deck.

- Officials:** We always appreciate the help of certified officials from other clubs. An Officials' Hospitality Room will be provided. Please let me know who your officials are that are attending.
- Timers:** Each team will be given timing assignments. Please designate a parent representative to report to the Head Timer 30 minutes prior to the start of the meet and/or any parent new to timing so they can receive some brief instruction. Thank you.
- Relay events:** The Relay event is also a Mixed sex event. You can combine any combination of athletes for your relay.
- Entry times:** As this is a B/C meet anyone entering with an "A" time in their respective age bracket will be scratched without notice. Please verify your entries in advance so no one gets scratched out of an event. You will not be notified of any scratches. Remember that relay swimmers may not swim a stroke they have an "A" time in for that relay.
- All 8 and under swimmers will start from the shallow end of the pool in the water and swim to the block end.

Note:

Swimmers with "A" times in their respective age group cannot swim those races in the open events.

- Officials:** We need each team to supply Officials to help with the meet. Please let me know ASAP to know who they are and how many you have. The more officials we have the better it is.
