Directions from I-5: Take Hwy 16 (Bremerton exit) to Hwy 3. Go north to Newberry Hill exit, turn right off exit. Turn right at light onto Bucklin Hill Road. Turn right onto Nels Nelson Road. Past the fairgrounds, Nels Nelson becomes Stampede. Turn right at entrance to high school. Pool is on the right, below stadium.

From Seattle ferry: Exit the ferry west on Washington Ave., which turns into 11th. Turn right onto Warren Ave. Across the bridge, Warren becomes Wheaton Way. Go about two miles, then turn left onto Fairgrounds Road. Turn left onto Stampede. Turn right at entrance to high school. Pool is on the right, below stadium.

ELIGIBILITY:

- All swimmers must be registered with USA Swimming and Pacific Northwest Swimming.
- Age groups are based on the age of the swimmer as of the first day of the meet. Ages and age groups for competition will be 8&under, 9-10, 11-12, and Open. The minimum age for Open events is 11. See Order of Events and Entry Information.
- **Qualifying and de-qualifying times:** See Special Information and Rules for each session.

ENTRY INFORMATION:

- Swimmers must meet the specific entry requirements for each individual event they enter.
- On-deck USA Swimming registration will not be permitted. **Comp**

- Deck entries for individual events will be allowed in open lanes during preliminary and pentathlon sessions only at the discretion of the Meet Referee. No deck entries during the finals sessions. Deck entry individual swims are not eligible for any awards, team points, or advancement from prelims to finals. Deck entry fees must be paid prior to the swim.
- Deck entered swimmers who are not already in the meet are required to show proof of USA Swimming athlete registration through PNS and complete a PNS Deck Entry Registration at the Clerk of Course in order to enter.
- **All USA Swimming registration numbers will be verified with the PNS registration database.**

ENTRY FEES:

- Surcharge: \$5.00
- Deck entry surcharge: \$10.00 (swimmer not previously in meet)
- Individual Event: \$3.00
- No refunds or credits will be given for events entered but not swum.
- All fees must accompany entries.

MEET RULES:

- Current PNS and USA Swimming rules govern throughout the meet, including warm-ups.
- Swimmers age 11-12 may enter either Open or Pentathlon events on Sunday – NOT BOTH - subject to the eligibility requirements for each.

SPECIAL INFORMATION AND RULES FOR OPEN SESSIONS:

- Each eligible swimmer may enter up to a maximum of three (3) individual events per day. Entries exceeding this limit will be scratched without notification, and entry fees for entry count limitation scratches will not be refunded.
 - Swimmers must be 11 or older.
 - Events will be swum and scored event number.
- Qualifying and de-qualifying times:** The qualifying/de-qualifying period for all age groups starts September 1, 2008.
- Swimmers age 11-12 must have achieved the 15&O PNS "Gold" time in each "Open" event entered.
 - Swimmers age 11-12 must not have achieved the 14&U PNS Champs qualifying time in their age group (any course) for each event entered.
 - Swimmers age 13-14 have no qualifying time but must not have achieved a 14&U PNS Champs time (any course) in each "Open" event entered.
 - Swimmers age 15&O have no qualifying time but must not have achieved a Washington State Short Course Champs time (any course) in each "Open" event entered.

Awards and Scoring:

- Individual events: Medals 1st-6th places; ribbons 7th-12th places.
- Scoring: 16-13-12-11-10-9-7-5-4-3-2-1

Special Open Session Rules:

- There will be two heats of finals for all 11&O prelims/finals events. See Order of Events for more information.

Scratch information:

- **Prelims:** No check-in required. No penalty for failure to show.
- **Finals:** These are preliminary/finals sessions, with two heats of each event in finals. Swimmers whose names are announced as qualifying

- for the finals or consolation heat of any prelims/finals event who fail to show will be barred from competing in the next individual event in which they are entered unless properly scratched. Once event results are announced, finalists and consolation finalists have 30 minutes to declare their intention to scratch. Swimmers declaring an intention to scratch will have until 30 minutes after the completion of their last preliminary event of the session to finalize their intention to scratch. There is no penalty for scratches during this time.
- Athletes who are seeded into an event as a result of other athletes scratching will not themselves be penalized for a failure to properly scratch. Reseeding to include scratches made after the scratch deadline may occur at the discretion of the Meet Referee.

SPECIAL INFORMATION AND RULES FOR PENTATHLON SESSIONS:

- Each 12&U Pentathlon swimmer may enter up to a maximum of five (5) individual events. Entries exceeding this limit will be scratched without notification, and entry fees for entry count limitation scratches will not be refunded.
- All 9-10 events will be seeded and swum together by gender, but scored separately by age group and gender (9 and 10). All 11-12 events will be seeded and swum together by gender, but scored separately by age group and gender (11 and 12).

De-qualifying times: Swimmers age 11 or 12 must not have achieved a 14&& PNS Champs qualifying time for their current age (any course), even if they chose not to enter 14&U PNS Champs. There are no de-qualifying times for 10&U swimmers.

Awards and Scoring:

- **Pentathlon Awards** for each age group and gender: 8&U, 9, 10, 11, and 12. The winners of the Pentathlon awards will be the swimmers with the least amount of accumulated time for the five events. A swimmer who is disqualified in one or more individual events is not eligible for Pentathlon Awards. Trophy for overall winner in each age group and gender with certificates for 2nd-6th places.
- **Ribbons:** 1st thru 6th for individual events in each awards age group.
- No team points.

Special Pentathlon Session Rules:

- To be eligible for Pentathlon awards, a swimmer must compete in all five events for his/her age group/gender.
- All Pentathlon events will be timed finals.

WARM-UP PROCEDURES FOR ALL SESSIONS:

- Circle swim counter-clockwise only.
- Last half hour of each warm-up period:
 - Lanes 1 & 6—pace lanes, no diving
 - Lanes 2 & 5—sprint lanes, dive starts, return in lanes 3 & 4
 - Lanes 3 & 4—general warm-up, no diving
 - Additional sprint lanes may be made available upon request to the Meet Referee.
- Pool closed promptly five (5) minutes prior to the start of competition.
- Warm-up may be modified at the discretion of the Meet Referee to accommodate the number of swimmers entered.

SAFETY:

- No diving from the blocks or sides of pool except for designated sprint lanes during designated times in main pool.
- Jumping into the pool is not allowed.
- Backstroke swimmers enter the water feet first in rotation; no diving over persons in the water.
- Deck Marshals will be assigned to supervise the warm-up. Deck Marshals have the authority to remove any swimmer, coach, or club who does not follow the safety rules during warm-ups or the meet.
- Coaches are responsible for their team's swimmers throughout the meet, including warm-ups and warm-downs.
- Swimmers who participate without their USA Swimming certified coach present must notify the Meet Referee prior to warm-up. The swimmer will be assigned to a coach.

OTHER NOTES:

- In granting this sanction it is understood and agreed that PNS and USA Swimming shall be free from any liabilities or claims for damages arising by reason of injuries to anyone during the conduct of the event.
- Only authorized volunteers and working personnel can be on deck. All others must remain in the designated spectator area and are not allowed in the designated racing venue unless timing for an event or volunteering with the management of the meet.
- In order to be on deck and serve in their official capacity, all coaches, officials and any other person required by sanction to be members of USA Swimming shall visibly display their membership credentials at all times.
- All persons acting in any coaching capacity must be coach members of USA Swimming.
- Alcoholic beverages, tobacco products of any kind, and glass containers are not allowed in the swimming venue.
- Any act of theft, vandalism or similar action will result in immediate disqualification from the meet and the loss of any points accumulated toward team standings by the individual.
- Team Areas: Please keep your area clean, and pick up all trash before leaving each session.

Submittal Notes:

- Late or incomplete entries will not be processed.
- Meet Entry Report or equivalent hardcopy must include full name of club, and, for each swimmer, first and last names, actual age as of the first day of the meet, gender, USA Swimming permanent 14-character identification number, events entered, and entry time for each.
- Recheck all entries as no additional entries or corrections will be accepted after the deadline (except deck entries).

ENTRY SUBMITTAL INFORMATION:

2. **Meet Entry Reports** for individual (sorted by swimmer) and relay (sorted by event) events from Team Manager—preferred—or equivalent hardcopy.
3. **Meet Entry Fee Report** from Team Manager—preferred—or equivalent hardcopy.
4. **Master Entry Summary Form**—Completed and hand-signed hardcopy only (original or faxed); typed signatures will not be accepted
5. **Meet Entry Fees**—one check payable to the Olympic Aquatic Club.

Important Note: Upon processing of the pre-meet exception report, PNS will register as a full-year USA Swimming athlete member any swimmer not then registered. PNS shall require the club or responsible party to pay an amount equal to the current full-year USA Swimming athlete registration fee, including the PNS surcharge, plus a \$15.00 fine for each athlete who is registered from the pre-meet exception report. The fines are due prior to the entry deadline of the next meet entered by the team being fined or within 15 business days after the receipt of the fine statement, whichever occurs first. See PNS AD 97-08 for additional information.
