- **Hospitality:** Refreshments will be available for coaches and officials in the Hospitality Room. Swimmers, timers, and spectators are not allowed.
- **Parking:** Available at the Aquatic Center and in the Federal Way Little League parking lot to the east. Illegally parked cars will be ticketed and towed by the Federal Way Police Dept. Do not leave valuables in vehicles. Carpooling is recommended.
- **RV Parking:** Limited RV parking is available in only the north parking lot. Dry camping--no sewer, water, or electricity.

ELIGIBILITY:

- All swimmers must be registered with USA Swimming and Pacific Northwest Swimming.
- Age groups are based on the age of the swimmer as of the first day of competition.
- Age groups for competition will be 10&under, 11-12, 13-14, and 15&over. See Order of Events.
- Entries must meet the published qualifying times. Entries that do not meet these standards will be scratched without notification and entry fees will not be refunded.
- Swimmers must have met the 2008 PNS Championship qualifying time in USA Swimming sanctioned, approved, or observed competition between April 1, 2007, and the entry deadline. Times achieved in compliance with PNS AD 02-01 during the qualifying period may also be used.
- A swimmer who enters a individual event at the Summer Grand Challenge may not compete in that event at this meet.

ENTRY INFORMATION:

- Each swimmer may enter up to a maximum of eight (8) individual events but no more than three (3) per day. Entries exceeding this limit will be scratched without notification, and entry fees for entry count limitation scratches will not be refunded.
- On-deck USA Swimming registration will not be permitted.
- Deck entries will not be permitted.
- **All USA Swimming registration numbers will be verified with the PNS registration database.**

PROOF OF TIME:

- All individual entry times submitted must be in USA Swimming's SWIMS database and will be reconciled with SWIMS.
- Alternate acceptable times complying with PNS AD 02-01 may also be submitted.
- Entry times neither in SWIMS nor complying with PNS AD 02-01 will be scratched without notification and entry fees will not be refunded.
- All entry times must be identified as LCM (long course meters), SCM (short course meters), or SCY (short course yards). Times not identified will be assumed to be LCM.
- Converted times are not allowed.

ENTRY FEES:

- Surcharge: \$15.00
- Individual Event: \$ 5.00
- Relay: \$10.00
- No refunds or credits will be given for events entered but not swum.
- All fees must accompany entries.

AWARDS AND SCORING:

- **Individual events:** Medals 1st-8th places; ribbons 9th - 16th places.
Scoring 20-17-16-15-14-13-12-11-9-7-6-5-4-3-2-1
- **Relay events:** Medals 1st - 3rd places; ribbons 4th - 8th places.
Scoring 40-34-32-30-28-26-24-22-18-14-12-10-8-6-4-2
- **Individual high point:** Winner each age group/gender
- **Team awards** 1st - 10th.
- **Presentation of medals** to the top three finishers will be made as indicated in the Finals Program. Awards for the top three finishers in each timed finals distance event will be made five minutes before the start of each day's finals. There will be no presentation of relay medals.

MEET RULES:

- Current PNS and USA Swimming rules govern throughout the meet, including warm-ups.
- Seeding will be LCM, SCM, SCY.
- This is a prelim/final meet for all events except:
 - All 10&U events
 - All relays
 - 400 IM and the 400, 800, and 1500M Freestyle events
- There will be two heats of finals for all 11-12, 13-14 and 15&O prelims/finals events See the Order of Events for more information.

Relays: Coaches are asked to turn in the original white copy of the relay slip one hour before the start of each relay event. Swimmers must take the pink lane copy of the relay slip with them to give to the timer in their lane to verify the order of swimmers participating.

Double ended: At the discretion of the Meet Referee, events 100 meters and longer may be swum double-ended. If double ended, the odd heats will start at the dive tank end and the even heats will start at the scoreboard end of the pool.

Distance Events:

11-12 400 IM, 400 Freestyle, and 800 Freestyle: These events will be

deck-seeded timed finals. A positive check-in with the Clerk of Course by the posted deadline is required in order to swim. Swimmers not checking in for these events will be scratched without penalty. Swimmers checking in for these events and failing to show for their swim will be disqualified from their next individual event in which they are entered. These events will be swum fastest to slowest in event number order.

- At the Meet Referee's discretion, the 400 and 800 Freestyle events may be swum two per lane. Should that be necessary, the fastest heat in each gender will have their own heat. When swimming two per lane and starting from both ends of the pool, each swimmer should--upon entry into the water--swim to the right side of the lane and remain on that side throughout the race; circle swimming would not be allowed.
- Swimmers must provide their own timer and counter, if desired. Lanes with no timer go unprotected.

13&O 400 IM, 400 Freestyle, and 800 Freestyle: These events will be deck-seeded timed finals events. A positive check-in with the Clerk of Course by the posted deadline is required in order to swim. Swimmers not checking in for these events will be scratched without penalty. Swimmers checking in for these events and failing to show for the swim will be disqualified from their next individual event in which they are entered.

- The top eight (8) swimmers in each age group and gender will be seeded separately and swim in age group order 13-14 then 15&O. The remaining swimmers will be seeded together by gender and swum fastest to slowest alternating girls and boys. Odd number heats will start at the dive tank end and even-numbered heats will start at the scoreboard end.
- At the Meet Referee's discretion, the 400 and 800 Freestyle events may be swum two per lane or seeded together (two girls' heats alternating with two boys' heats). When swimming two per lane and starting from both ends of the pool, each swimmer should--upon entry into the water--swim to the right side of the lane and remain on that side throughout the race; circle swimming would not be allowed.
- Swimmers must provide their own timer and counter, if desired. Lanes with no timer go unprotected.
- These events will be scored and awarded separately by age group and gender.

11&O 1500 Freestyle: These events will be deck-seeded timed finals for all age groups. A positive check-in with the Clerk of Course by the posted deadline is required in order to swim. Swimmers not checking in for these events will be scratched without penalty. Swimmers checking in for these events and failing to show for the swim will be disqualified from their next individual event in which they are entered.

- The top-seeded eight (8) swimmers in each gender and age group who check in will be seeded separately and will swim in the following order: youngest to oldest alternating girls and boys (11/12 girls, 11/12 boys, 13/14 girls, etc.).
- The remaining heats will be seeded and swum together fastest to slowest, alternating girls and boys. At the Meet Referee's discretion, these heats may be swum two per lane or seeded together (two girls' heats alternating with two boys' heats). When swimming two per lane

- and starting from both ends of the pool, each swimmer should--upon entry into the water--swim to the right side of the lane and remain on that side throughout the race; circle swimming would not be allowed.
- Swimmers must provide their own timer and counter, if desired. Lanes with no timer go unprotected.
 - These events will be scored and awarded separately by age group and gender.

SCRATCH PROCEDURE:

- **Pre-seeded events:** There is no penalty for a failure to swim a pre-seeded individual or relay event. This includes all 10&U and 11-12 individual events, all relay events, and preliminary heats of all 13-14 and 15&O individual events.
- **Finals and Consolations:** Swimmers qualifying for the finals or consolation heats of any prelims/finals event who fail to show will be barred from competing in the rest of the meet, unless properly scratched.
- **Intention to Scratch:** Once the finalists, consolation finalists, and two alternates are announced, those swimmers have 30 minutes to declare their intention to scratch and until 30 minutes after the completion of their last preliminary (not timed finals) event to finalize their intention to scratch. There is no penalty for scratches during this time.
- Athletes who are not announced finalists, consolation finalists, or alternates 30 minutes after the announcement of an event's results will not be penalized for a failure to scratch. However, reseeding may result from scratches during that period. Reseeding due to scratches made after the initial 30 minute deadline will be at the discretion of the Meet Referee.

WARM-UP PROCEDURES:

- Circle swim counter-clockwise only.
- Last half hour of each warm-up period:
 - Lanes 1 & 8—pace lanes, no diving
 - Lanes 2 & 7—sprint lanes, dive starts, return in lanes 3 & 6
 - Lanes 3, 4, 5 & 6—general warm-up, no diving
 - Additional sprint lanes may be made available upon request to the Meet Referee.
- Pool closed promptly five (5) minutes prior to the start of competition.
- Warm-up may be modified at the discretion of the Meet Referee to accommodate the number of swimmers entered.

SAFETY:

- No diving from the blocks or sides of pool except for designated sprint lanes during designated times in main pool.
- Jumping into the pool is not allowed.
- Backstroke swimmers enter the water feet first in rotation; no diving over persons in the water.
- Deck Marshals will be assigned to supervise the warm-up. Deck Marshals have the authority to remove any swimmer, coach, or club who does not follow the safety rules during warm-ups or the meet.
- Coaches are responsible for their team's swimmers throughout the meet, including warm-ups and warm-downs.

- Swimmers who participate without their USA Swimming certified coach present must notify the Meet Referee prior to warm-up. The swimmer will be assigned to a coach.

OTHER NOTES:

- In granting this sanction it is understood and agreed that PNS and USA Swimming shall be free from any liabilities or claims for damages arising by reason of injuries to anyone during the conduct of the event.
- Only credentialed athletes, coaches, officials, authorized volunteers and facility employees are allowed on deck or in the locker rooms. All volunteers must check in prior to their assigned shift for a name tag which must be displayed while on deck.
- All others must remain in the designated spectator area or in public lobbies and are not allowed in the natatorium unless timing for an event in which swimmers must provide their own timers.
- In order to be on deck and serve in their official capacity, all coaches, officials, meet directors and any other person required by sanction to be members of USA Swimming shall visibly display their membership credentials at all times.
- All persons acting in any coaching capacity must be coach members of USA Swimming.
- Alcoholic beverages, tobacco products of any kind, and glass containers are not allowed in the swimming venue.
- Any act of theft, vandalism or similar action will result in immediate disqualification from the meet and the loss of any points accumulated toward team standings by the individual.
- **Team Areas:** Please keep your area clean, and pick up all trash before leaving each session.
- **Lost and Found:** Items will be left in place during the meet. After the meet, contact KCAC.
- **Team Banners:** Banners must be fabric. No helium balloons or paper signs.

N2 CERTIFICATION FOR OFFICIALS:

This meet has been designated as a training meet for N2 Officials Certification. Officials wishing to renew or obtain this level of certification must apply on the attached application form and notify Peter Keane, Meet Referee. Instructions for certification will be provided during the officials briefing.

ENTRY SUBMITTAL INFORMATION: Before processing your entries, click on "Enforce Qualifying Times" and "Use Since Date" filter and set "Use Times Since" to April 1, 2007.

Entries will be only be accepted upon receipt of all of the following prior to the entry deadline, **Wednesday July 23, 2008.**

1. **COMMLINK** file exported from Team Manager, if used.
2. **Meet Entry Reports** for individual (Proof of Time format sorted by swimmer) and relay (sorted by event) events from Team Manager—preferred—or equivalent hardcopy.
3. **Meet Entry Fee Report** from Team Manager—preferred—or equivalent hardcopy.
4. **Master Entry Summary Form**—Completed and hand-signed hardcopy only (original or faxed); typed signatures will not be accepted

- **Hardcopies:** mail, hand-deliver, or fax. If sending via express mail, waive signature requirement.
- **Disk:** 3 ½ inch floppy disk (double density or high density), CD, or DVD, which should be mailed or delivered in a protective envelope
- To ensure correct entries, teams that do not have Team Manager or equivalent software can use Hy-Tek Lite to complete and submit entries for this meet. It is available at <http://www.hy-tekld.com/downloads.html> at no charge.

Submittal Notes:

- Late or incomplete entries will not be processed.
- Handwritten entries will not be processed.
- Meet Entry Report or equivalent hardcopy must include full name of club, and, for each swimmer, first and last names, actual age as of the first day of the meet, gender, USA Swimming permanent 14-character identification number, events entered, and entry time for each. In addition, proof of time information must include the name and date of the meet at which the entry time was achieved.
- Relay-only swimmers must be listed on the Meet Entry Report or equivalent, and appropriate surcharges must be included with the entry.
- Recheck all entries as no additional entries or corrections will be accepted after the deadline (except deck entries).
