April had more highlights than the Dolph-a-thon for the DCD swimmers as Heidi Tieu, Jonathan Mui, and Jose Lazo were part of the 2007 AAA San Francisco Swimming Championships April 14, at Herbst Natatorium, at Saint Ignatius High School. Heidi, representing Washington High School, closed out her high school career by winning the girls varsity 100 breaststroke. She also was fourth in the 200 IM, and was part of the 3rd place 200 medley and 200 free relays. Jonathan was 3rd in the varsity 100 breast and 5th in the 200 free and was part of the gold medal 200 free relay for Lowell High School. Jose, also swimming for Lowell, took the gold in the junior varsity 50 free, 200 medley and free relay. He was also 3rd in the 100 free.

The next day at the same pool the DCD class of 2006 made their debut at the Fog City Hammerhead Practice Meet. Swimming their first meet for DCD were Eric & Shannon Do, Adam Kolton-Mitlyng, Anson Lee, Caroline Sheng, and Lizzie Wu. Although not at their first meet, great swims came from: Daniel Moloney winning the 8/un boys 100 IM, Martin Leung winning the 50 back, 25 & 50 free in the same division, Trevor Chan taking the 11-12 boys 100 free, Kristen Chan taking the silver in the 10/un girls 100 IM, Ashley Davis 2nd in the 11-12 girls 100 breast, Jazmine Williams also second in the 8/u girls 50 breast. Also swimming best times and winning awards were: Noah Davis, Andrew & Brian Fong, Adrian Lee, Albert Liu, Roland & Rosalyn Wang.

1. Call Meeting to Order at 7:30 p.m.
2. Approve d March 23, 2007 minutes as read
3. Jefferson Pool Status
 - a. We will start using Jefferson again next Monday, April 23, 2007
 - b. The cost is \$30/hour payable to the Jefferson school district
 - c. Tim Stember will use Calling Post to let families know
 - d. The Board discussed the financial impact of this additional expense which will be about \$1,200 to \$1,500/month or \$14,400 to \$18,000/year depending on the number of hours the pool is used each month. It may be necessary to raise dues at some point to cover these costs. The Board decided to monitor the costs for the next few months to see the impact on the team's finances and decide later on whether an increase is necessary.
