- FACILITY:** **6 lane, 25 meter** outdoor pool. Bathrooms and showers available. Limited bleacher seating; teams are encouraged to bring chairs. There is no smoking permitted at the facility or within 30-feet of the perimeter fence.
- Computer scoring and electronic timing with touchpads and both electronic and manual stopwatches.
- Swimmers are not permitted to swim in any other areas of the pool during the meet.
- TEAM AREAS:** Each team will have an assigned “team area.” Refer to map of facility (attached). Teams are permitted to bring “pop up tents” and **TENT STAKES ARE PERMITTED.** Teams will be permitted to store tents at the facility overnight (starting at 6pm Monday) but they must be taken down at the end of each session.
- ENTRY FEES:** \$10.00/swimmer. Checks payable to SSCL. SWIM meet fees are due by 9:00AM on July 12, 2016 (*present team fee at scorers table*).
- SUBMITTING ENTRIES:** There will be an event list emailed to each team designee on Sunday, July 10, 2016. Submit your electronic entry files to Kim Kessler.
- Entries are due by **Friday, July 8, 2016 at 6PM.** Kim Kessler will distribute combined entries on Saturday, July 9, 2016. Coaches will have (24) hours to request changes.
- No new entries are permitted after the 6PM deadline. **NO DECK ENTRIES.** Any changes received after (24) hours will not be considered. You will be notified that your entries have been received and successfully entered.

The meet will be pre-seeded and a heat sheet available at the meet for \$2.00/each.

ENTRY LIMITATIONS:

All participants must be currently registered to a team in the SSCL. Participant's age on June 1, 2016 determines age group. Swimmers must have participated in at least two (2) SSCL meets. Refer to the SSCL bylaws for all specific rules, which will govern this championship meet. Entry limitations: 10 & under swimmers can compete in a maximum of three (3) events, including relays. 11 & older swimmers can compete in a maximum of (4) events, including relays. Please refer to league bylaws regarding relay alternate submissions.

PARKING:

Please encourage team members to carpool. The parking lot between Annehurst Elementary School and the pool will be reserved for coaches, officials, employees, and those with Handicap Parking Permits (parking attendants will provide you with a pass to put in your windshields at the event – all names are to be provided to Annehurst Volunteer Coordinator prior to the event). Parent and Visitor parking will be in the grass and/or in the adjacent neighborhoods.

All access to the pool will be from 925 W. Main Street, Westerville, OH 43081 (Annehurst Elementary School address).

Please see the attached maps regarding Swimmer Drop-off prior to parking. Safety is the ultimate concern for all. (2) way exiting traffic will be provided as indicated on the map.

In case of inclement weather, parking in the grass area may not be available and parking will be required in the adjacent neighborhood. This decision will not be made until the day of the event. Either way ample parking is available close to the pool.

POTENTIAL SHELTER:

In the event the meet is delayed due to weather, there will be an opportunity for Annehurst Elementary School to be used for shelter (gym, student dining and main corridor).

MEET PROCEDURE:

All events, including relays, will be pre-seeded with the first heat of each event comprised of the SLOWEST times entered and the last heat comprised of the FASTEST times entered. The 15-minute rule will not be in effect, so please use your judgment when entering swimmers in back-to-back events. Refer to the order of events in the SSCL bylaws.

BULLPEN:

The bullpen for 10 & under swimmers will be located on the attached map near the pool entrance. Each team is responsible for providing at least (1) volunteer to help ensure their team's swimmers are in the bullpen area for their events. The volunteers should be in a position to seek out their own swimmers if necessary. **We ask that coaches or team representatives go over bullpen procedures and expectations with their swimmer so that the athletes know what to expect when they get into the bullpen.** There will be NO bullpen for the 11 & older swimmers during the morning session.

TIMERS:

The Annehurst Swim Team will be responsible for providing (6) timers during the competition. Each of the remaining (4) teams will be responsible for providing (2) timers for EACH session of competition. Electronic timing pads will be used. Should the pads malfunction, the average of the two backup timers will be used.

VOLUNTEERS:

Volunteers should check in near the main entrance under the canopy near the T-Shirt/Concession Area a minimum of (20) minutes prior to each session start. Volunteers will receive a complimentary T-Shirt. Please provide T-Shirt sizes for all volunteers.

OFFICIATING RULES:

USA Swimming rules will govern the meet and the USA rulebook is the official guide for the SSCL as modified within the SSCL bylaws.

PRIVACY:

Use of audio or visual recording devices, including a cell phone, is not permitted in changing areas, rest rooms, or locker rooms.

SPECIAL NEEDS:

SSCL will follow the guidelines established in the USA swimming and diving rules, Article 105, Guidelines for Officiating Swimmers with a Disability in USA Swimming Meets, with **one** (1) exception. SSCL **will** permit aids to buoyancy for an affected limb(s) of a swimmer who may need it due to a disability. President of the SSCL league shall inform referee of this exception prior to meets.

The coach of the swimmer with a disability shall be responsible for informing the other coaches, referee and league president.

CONCESSIONS:

Concessions and hospitality will be provided during the meet. The concession stand will accept credit/debit cards through Square for purchase of \$5 or more. Coaches, officials, and volunteers will be provided complimentary food and drink by hospitality.

T-SHIRTS:

A limited amount of T-Shirts will be available at the meet for \$15.

Pre-orders are due by Wednesday, July 6, 2016 and should be organized and submitted by each Team. The shirts will be available for pickup at the meet.

PHOTOS:

Photography may be provided at the meet. More information will be provided at a later date or at the meet.

SCORING:

Every heat of every event will be scored as a timed final.
Individual and relay events will be scored as follows:

Team points for relays are as listed in the SSCL bylaws for scoring. Team points for individual events are as listed in the SSCL bylaws for scoring.

AWARDS:

Swimming: For individual events, medals are given for first through third place and ribbons are given for fourth through sixteenth place. For relays, medals are given for first through third place and ribbons are given for fourth through twelfth place.

Championship Meet Team Awards:

Junior Champion – Swimming: The team with the highest combined points for swimming for those participants ages 10 and under. A plaque will be awarded. This award is non-rotational.

Senior Champion – Swimming: The team with the highest combined points for swimming for those participants ages 11 and older. A plaque will be awarded. This award is non-rotational.

Overall Team Champion Plaque: Swimming: The team with the highest combined points for junior and senior swimming. A plaque is awarded which rotates from winning club to winning club on a yearly basis. The club in possession of the plaque is responsible for bringing it to the championship meet the following year.

AWARDS DELIVERY:

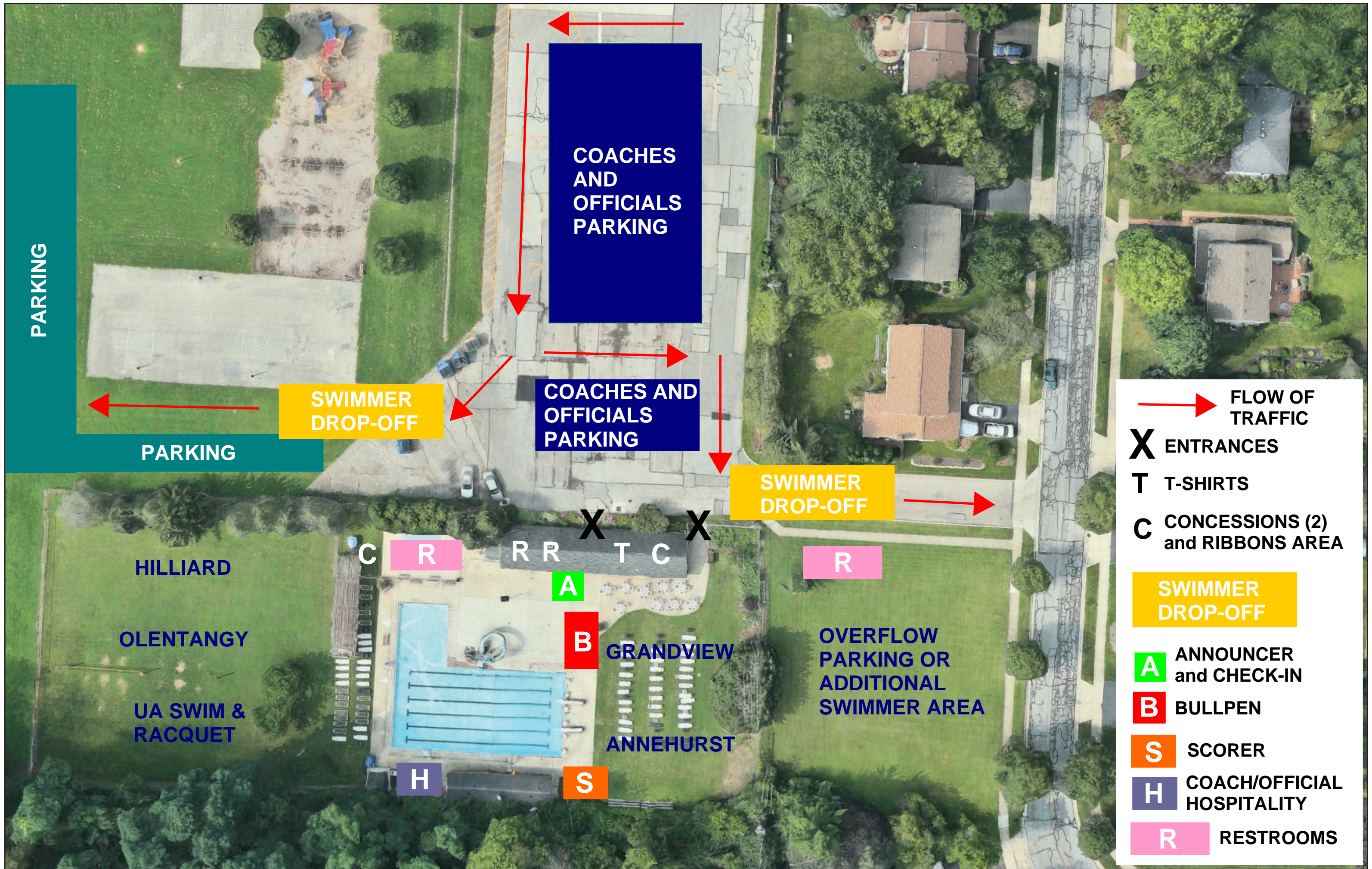
Awards will be sorted by teams and should be picked up by coaches at the meet. Awards will be available as soon as possible after the meet.
