

2010 ODSL SCHOLARSHIP PROGRAM

Introduction

The ODSL scholarship program provides partial college scholarships to one deserving young woman and one deserving young man each swim season. The scholarships will be awarded based on a demonstrated sportsmanship, citizenship and a commitment to the sport of swimming that resulted in a positive impact on their own development and the ODSL as a whole. The scholarships will be awarded at the end of each season at the All-Star Swim Meet.

The 2010 Scholarship award amount will be \$500.00 per recipient.

Eligibility

Applicants are eligible to apply for a scholarship award in their senior year of high school (or their final season of eligibility in the ODSL) as they intend to enter college or an institution of higher education. Each applicant must have been an active ODSL swimmer for at least the two prior seasons.

Application

Eligible participants must submit their completed applications to the ODSL Scholarship Committee **no later than 12:00 PM (noon), Friday, July 23, 2010**. Please email applications to ramonaremember@verizon.net and your ODSL Team Representative. Included in the application package must be:

- One letter of recommendation from your ODSL Team Representative, Team governing organization or Team Head Coach.
- A completed ODSL scholarship application form.
- Documentation showing next level of education
- A 400-500 essay on the "how the sport of swimming has benefited your life and the lessons you will take into adulthood."

Selection

A selection committee, composed of at least two ODSL Team Representatives will be established to review all applications. The committee may elect to interview candidates in order to make final recommendation to the league.

Award Ceremony

The awards will be announced and funds will be distributed in the form of a check at the All-Star Meet.

Judging Criteria

The scholarship committee will award each area points ranging on a 1-10 scale with 1 being low and 10 being high. The male and female with the highest points will be awarded the scholarship. In the event of a tie, the committee shall interview the tied applicants to make their final decision.

Letter of recommendation from team

Contributions made to team or ODSL

Essay
