## AMERICAN RED CROSS LIFEGUARD TRAINING

An American Red Cross Lifeguarding will be conducted at Gloucester County Institute of Technology (G.C.I.T.). This core course will teach you the skills and knowledge needed to prevent and respond to aquatic emergencies. The course includes three-year certification in Lifeguarding and First Aid and a one-year certification in CPR/AED for Lifeguards.

Prerequisites- Swim 300 yards using front crawl or breast stroke without stopping. Swim 150 of either front crawl or breast stroke or combination of two strokes. Students must also swim 20 yards of front crawl or breast stroke, surface dive to a depth of 7 feet, retrieve a 10 pound object, return to the surface, and swim 20 yards back to starting point with object and exit water without using a ladder or steps within 1 minute 40 seconds.
