# *Aquadart*

## *Swimmer of the Month*

### *May 2008*

#### *Carrie Wesnousky*

We know there is a *Miss America* and we know there is a *Miss California*, but what you might not know is that IF there was a *Miss Aquadart* we'd have one of those as well. And that swimmer would be Carrie Wesnousky.

Carrie is the May Swimmer of the Month partially for her performance at the SJS High School Champs but more so for her career-long contributions and membership on the team.

Except for the spring HS swim seasons Carrie has been a continuous member of the Aquadarts for 11 years and 9 months. Carrie joined in Sept of 1996, when she was 6 1/2 years old, went to her first swim meet that very month and hasn't stopped tearing up the water since.

She's been an integral part of everything the Aquadarts have done over the past decade, both in and out of the pool, but she's best known for simply going to meets and racing.

Incredibly, during her time on the team Carrie competed in 157 meets and—picture this— in 954 individual events. Add years of relay swims to that number and Carrie easily comes up with over 1000 races as an Aquadart.

Not surprisingly, during all those years, Carrie also became one the all-time fastest Aquadarts. In the 2002-03 swim year, she set 6 Team Records (yards and meters) in the 400 IM, 800/1000 and 1500/1650. She added 4 more the following swim year in those same distance events plus the 200 fly.

Carrie gravitated to those distance events when they were new to the 11-12 age group and first added by USAS back in 2001. Because of her dedication and consistent attendance she began excel

ling at the longer races where her new-found success took her to record heights and experiences.

Carrie's been a member of the Sierra Nevada All-Star Dual Meet Team, the Sierra Nevada Western Zones team and the SNS Distance Team in Colorado Springs.

Carrie's been a member of our own Aquadart Senior group since 2003 and has consistently contributed to Team Awards at the local and regional level. (In Feb. 2006, she was well on her way to great swims at the San Diego Senior Classic before suffering a season-ending ankle injury from a random jumping accident inside an elevator).

Carrie has lived in Davis her entire life with her sister Alex (19), her mother Katy and her father John.

Katy has represented the Aquadarts as well, serving on the Board of Directors the past 4 years as Treasurer.

Carrie and her family have traveled occasionally, usually during the team training break in August. She visited Spain & Portugal while in 8th grade, Italy during the 10th and the British Virgin Islands somewhere in there also. She and her mom are looking forward to a trip to Ireland immediately following her HS graduation next week.

Carrie will attend Connecticut College in New London, Conn, this fall where, obviously, she plans on



swimming

She's an avid reader, often seen finishing the pages of a book as practice begins and teammates are diving in. Carrie and her mom are Jane Austin aficionados and Carrie is one of the original fans of 'West Wing'.

Her advice to her younger teammates is to 'take time to enjoy the people they practice with. Their teammates may end up being their best friends'.

Of all the things Carrie would want to be remembered for probably the most important is that by understanding what being on the *team* meant she truly was 'An Aquadart'.
