Neptune Swimming is one of the top 100 swim teams in the United States and has been named a Silver Medal Club for four straight years by USA Swimming.

That dedication has produced Junior and Senior National finalists, a Senior National champion, a 2004 U.S. Open champion, qualifiers in the 2000, 2004 and 2008 Olympic Trials, and numerous All-American swimmers—recognized nationally for their academic and athletic excellence. While not all stories end on the Olympic stand, all team members experience the satisfaction of setting goals and achieving new personal bests.

With sites in Santa Rosa and Healdsburg, Neptune Swimming now trains nearly 300 swimmers. The rigorous training required year-round to compete in the sport of swimming produces positive results outside of the pool such as self-discipline, time-management and goal-setting. Many of our team members are honor roll students, academic achievement award winners and nominees for Academic All-Americans. Many demonstrate a responsibility to our community by helping with homeless shelters, food and clothing drives, senior programs and environmental clean-up projects. Additionally they are involved in leadership positions at their schools as members of student government. These talented young people are the future leaders of our community.
