Scoring: The fastest 8 prelims times qualifying for the Championship Finals; the next fastest 8 times qualify for the Consolation Finals. The Championship Finals will swim following the Consolation Finals. Any vacancies in the Consolation Finals will be filled by the 17th and 18th finisher from the prelims; they must stand near the referee in case their name is called.

YOU MUST INCLUDE RELAYS.** Use the enclosed Master Entry Form, one for boys and one for girls or HyTek. Make sure home and business phone numbers are mentioned. List each swimmer's first and last name, year in school, and the time for event. Entry sheet should be signed by each coach; relay cards will be provided the morning of the meet. Seeding and results will be handled by Eva Gronke also. **Emailed entries PREFERRED!! FOR USA SWIMMERS TIMES TO BE RECOGNIZED USA SWIMMERS ID MUST BE INCLUDED.**

Each team is allowed 4 athletes per event; each athlete shall be limited to 4 events, no more than 2 of which may be individual events. Follow all rules of the NFHS rules book and the FHSAA general regulations.

Relays: Any swimmer on your Master Entry Form may be eligible for a relay prior to the start of the relay events; you must turn in your relay card listing your relay swimmers. You may list up to 8 swimmers. Be sure to identify which ones will be swimming Prelims lead-off Swimmer must be listed as #1 and Finals. Remember: you MAY NOT scratch a swimmer from an individual event in order to swim an additional relay.
