- IV. Programs Operations- Evelyn Kramer discussed sanctioned meets and asked that coaches send in information as soon as possible and not wait until the end of the season.
- V. Coaches Representative – Dave Montgomery spoke about the selection of Kentucky athletes for the Olympic Training camp in Colorado.

- VI. The Long Course Zone Coaches will be Scott Paulson (Caritas), Jamie Norton (High Bridge), Lori Fisher (Screaming Eagles), and Jan Goff (manager).
- VII. John Brucato reviewed the disbursement of travel funds. (see attached report) The Junior Nationals has been changed to sectionals after long course 2000. Kentucky will be in the Central Sectional.
- VIII. Records Chairman: Carol Foster distributed packets for coaches present. All teams should have current Kentucky state records at this time.
- IX. Officials Chairman: Jan Goff reported that the all whistle starts will be used from this point forward.
- X. Athletes Representative: Lisa Petry discussed the athlete awards. The response at the state meet was much better than in previous seasons for nominations for Kentucky athletes. The swimmers feel that the Zone selection process works well but they want the mandatory camp day to include more time getting to know swimmers.
- XI. Rules Vice Chairman – Steve Hornbeck stated that at the Fall HOD meeting the one hundred dollar fine for failure to be represented at the HOD meeting was put in place.
