2010 Central American and Caribbean Games, Puerto Rico (The Aquatics competition was held in the city of Mayaguez).

2010 Central America and Mexico Swimming Championship (CAMEX XIII) held in Nueva Guatemala, Guatemala. This competition had to be rescheduled from July to November due to the eruption of the Pacaya volcano near Guatemala City.

2010 Caribbean Island Swimming Championships (CISC IXXX) was hosted by Cuba in Havana City. For the first time, CISC XXII included competitions in all five disciplines.

2009 Central American and Caribbean Island Swimming Championships (CCCAN XXVI) was held in Barquisimeto, Venezuela. CCCAN XXXVI was scheduled to be held in Mexico, but a SARS outbreak in the region forced CCCAN to move the Championship to Barquisimeto.

2008 Central America and Mexico Swimming Championship (CAMEX XII) held in San Jose, Costa Rica.

2008 Caribbean Island Swimming Championships (CISC IXX) was held in Kingston, Jamaica.
