I have the pleasure to send you the following information concerning the organisation of the *FINA Coaches Certification Course - Coach Level* (*L2*) scheduled to be held in Kingston, Jamaica, from 26th to 30th January 2020.

Please note the following information related to the FINA Coaches Certification Programme and the coaches certification pathway:

Eligibility

- The FINA Coaches Certification Courses –Coach Level (L2) are open to all the National Federations who have active coaches requiring more in-depth training at an intermediate level.
- They are designed for those candidates that have completed the FINA Coaches Certification Course – Assistant Level (L1) or an equivalent coaching course recognized by FINA, preparing them for coaching duties in swimming.
- Participants must be at least 18 years old at the start of the FINA Coaches Certification Programme.

Registration

- Each FINA Coaches Certification Course requires a minimum of 10 and may have a maximum of 30 participants.
- As per the <u>FINA Coaches Certification Pathway</u> (page 7), candidates must be registered through the FINA GMS by the established deadline and their profiles must include the following information: personal data, photo, passport/National ID copy and
