COMMENTS

In the first quarter final game, Argentina took care of business from the start, beating Trinidad and Tobago 24-3. With the win, Argentina qualifies for the semi-final round against Canada. They also automatically qualify for the 2020 World Youth Championships. Solid defense, strong center forward shots and consistent counter attacks from turnovers led the south American team to gain a quick advantage in the first half 12-0. During the third quarter, Trinidad and Tobago was able to score from an extra man opportunity and form the perimeter for their first two goals of this quarter final game. Not to be outdone, Argentina came back and scored four goals to increase their lead heading to the last quarter. The last part of the game was all Argentina. They scored on their last eight possessions to close out the game with a big lead. They were led in scoring by Agnesina (#9) with six goals. Trinidad and Tobago was led by Green (#3) with two goals. They will go against Peru for 5th-6th place in these championships in the first game of tomorrow's session. Argentina will face Canada in the second game of the session.

COMMENTS

Brazil and Peru played for the last semi-final spot and the automatic qualifying spot for the 2020 World Youth Championship. Both teams exchanged goals in the first 5 minutes of the quarter. It was then that Brazil scored two straight goals, one 5 meter shot from the middle and one from 11 meters out, to get a 4-2 to finish the first quarter. Tight defense and solid consistent offense was what Brazil brought in the second quarter. Peru's offense couldn't develop a steady game while Brazil was scoring in every chance they had. The second quarter ended with Brazil on top 10-3. Brazil's consistent game kept the pressure on Peru for the entire second half. The Brazilians were able to keep scoring from their extra man opportunities, were very accurate with their perimeter shooting and counter attacked every opportunity. They scored twelve goals in the second half for three to Peru, winning by an ample margin. Brazil, who plays USA in the second semi-final game of tomorrow's session, was led in scoring by Amaral (#6) with six goals. Rodriguez (#11) was Peru's top gun with four goals. They will play Trinidad tomorrow for 5th and 6th place.
