12 and Under State Swim Meet Parking: Just a heads up to our parents and workers, due to safety and liability issues the Schroeder Aquatic Center had hired a private parking company to handle its parking lot for our meet. Many of you working the meet will be there earlier than the general spectators, so should be able to get into the free parking, but you might want to keep the following in mind on the days of the meet you are going to be attending/working.

Preferred Parking is available in the East parking lot at a rate of \$5.00 per day.

General Parking is available in the West parking lot at no charge on a first come first serve basis.

Overflow Parking is also available behind Old Navy located in the shopping mall just southwest of the aquatic center. There is a path back to the aquatic center.

The parking fees are not funds that Schroeder or SWAT gets to keep, they are to generate revenue that the facility has to pay to the hired parking company as mandated by their insurance carrier.

Session End dates: The Wisconsin Silver Meet represents the end of this session for most groups. The last schedule practice for 12 and Under Non-State qualifiers is Thursday, July 16th. The last scheduled practice for Senior Silver, Senior Gold and Junior Gold 13&Over non state qualifiers is Friday, July 17. Junior/Senior Platinum swimmers who are non-state will follow the 13&O Non-State practice Schedule until 8/2/09.

Additional Training: Any 13 & Over swimmer who wishes to continue training from July 20 to August 6, may do so for an additional \$60 for the added 3 weeks of training. You would follow the current schedule, designated for 13 & Over Non-State. Fees must be mailed to the office by July 17th to participate, so we can anticipate coaching needs. By WIAA rules, most high school girls will begin practices with their high school teams on Tuesday, August 11, so the added 3 weeks should keep you in the best shape possible to start your high school season. Escrow Accounts: As we near the end of the season, for those of you who will be done after the Silver meet, please check your on line account and pay any past due entry fees from this season. All accounts have been billed up to the Silver Meet. If you are low or past due and are also participating in the State meet or Speedos, include additional funds to cover those meets.

Officials Training: An officials certification class has been added, to be held at Waukesha South HS on July 18th – Registration is due by Friday, 7/10. Please see attached document if interested. SWAT will reimburse the \$25 registration fee for those who take the class. The classes are very basic and thorough, so don't feel like you need to have some special qualifications to become an official. Congrats and thank you to Sarah Schneider (Perez) and Paul Conrad who recently took the stroke and turn clinic and have begun shadowing at meets to complete their certification. SWAT is proud of and grateful to have 2 more officials representing our team.

At the Clinic: View DVD on strokes, turns, and relay exchanges; lecture; and ample discussion. Please bring pen and paper for taking notes. Beverages and snacks are provided.

After Clinic: Participants take USA Swimming on-line, open book test & apprentice four Meet sessions.
