A break of at least two (2) hours shall be scheduled between preliminaries and finals with the pool available for warm-ups during the last hour. The exact time for afternoon warm-ups and competition will be determined by the referee and announced as early as possible each day.

Warm-ups will be conducted in accordance with Alaska Swimming Warm-up/Warm-down procedures. See attached.

Coaches/

Officials meeting: There will be a coaches/officials meeting prior to the beginning of the meet on Friday.

Eligibility: Open to all Southeast Alaska swimmers age 18 and younger currently registered as athlete members with USA and Alaska Swimming. Qualified times may be made at USS sanctioned and approved meets and time trials as well as Alaska High School Regional and State Championships provided USS officials are on deck whose sole purpose is to observe that the individual swims conform to the USS rules and regulations. Swimmers must swim in the age bracket corresponding to their age on the first day of the meet.

Membership

Verification:

Verification of athlete's membership in USA Swimming shall be made by signature of a club official or coach on the coach-athlete verification form. Forms submitted without the proper signature may not be accepted. Penalties for falsifying membership shall be imposed as per AS Guide Article 8.4 Verification form must accompany entries.

Rules:

Current USA and Alaska Swimming rules will govern this meet. Swimmers may enter a total of seven (7) events, with no more than three (3) events per day. This is exclusive of relay events. All events shall be conducted with preliminaries and finals on the same day with the exception of the 400 IM and 500 freestyle which shall be conducted as timed final/consolidated events and swum fastest to slowest alternating girls/boys with girls swimming first during their respective preliminary sessions. The 1650 freestyle shall be conducted as times final/consolidated event and swum fastest to slowest alternating girls/boys with the girls swimming first during the finals session. The fastest two (2) heats of all relays shall be swum as timed finals during the finals sessions with all other heats of relays swum as timed finals during the preliminary sessions. All 10/U events will be conducted as timed finals during the finals session. Relay events shall have no qualifying times. Age groups shall be as follows for all relay events: 10/U, 11/12, 13/14 and 15/18. A swim team/club may enter no more than two (2) non-qualified swimmers per relay event. This meet will be run as a "no recall meet". Whistle starts will be used.

Scratch Rules:

The individual scratch rule for events will be in effect as stated in the Alaska Swim Guide Article 3.A.8.a,b.

The relay scratch rule will be applied as stated in the Alaska Swim Guide 3.A.9.a,b.1,2,3.

Scratches shall be made each day and delivered to the meet director on the attached scratch form no later than 6:00 p.m. prior to the next day's events.

A swimmer will be considered entered unless his/her coach has officially scratched him/her from the event.

Entry Information:

The preferred method is to email your entries on or before November 20, 2002 and mail your hard copies, 3.5 disk and your check via regular mail. All entries,

including Relay-Only entries, shall be submitted on consolidated entry cards and a master entry form (recap sheet) OR 3.5 disk via the Hy-Tek software COMMLINK file using the build option. As a backup please send a Hy-Tek software Team Manager entry report.

Complete the front of the relay cards only to accompany entries. Names of relay swimmers are to be presented at the computer desk one half hour before warm-ups each day. Entered times may be aggregate times of individual swimmers or a relay composite time.

The name, telephone number and e-mail address of the entry contact person must be included with the entries.

Meet Fees:

Swimmer surcharge \$5.00

Swimmer entry fee \$4.50

Individual event fee \$2.00

Relay event fee \$8.00

Meet fees are to be included with the entries. Please make checks to **Ketchikan Killer Whales Swim Club** and submit with financial recap.

All entries must be postmarked or e-mailed no later than midnight **Wednesday, November 27, 2002.** Late entries will not be accepted.

E-mailing entries on a COMMLINK file is strongly encouraged with a hard copy follow-up to be sent in the mail.

Scoring:

Scores shall be kept on combined team scores and individual scores.

Individual scores through 6th place: 7-5-4-3-2-1.

Relay scores through 6th place: 14-10-8-6-4-2

Awards:

Individual: Medals will be awarded for 1st-3rd place.

Ribbons will be awarded for 4th-6th places.

Relays: Medals will be awarded for 1st-3rd place and ribbons for 4th-6th place.

Individual high point awards will be given to the top three boys and girls in each age group and to the top three combined teams.

There will be two (2) additional team awards. There will be an award to the team that earns the most points per swimmer as well as an award for the team with the highest percentage of individual best times.

To be eligible for both of these awards a team must be represented by at least twelve (12) swimmer participants at the meet.

The percentage of best times award will go to the team with the highest percentage of best times compared to the number of individual swims (there must be a minimum of 100 swims to be eligible) in the meet. Disqualification's, scratches, and "no-shows" do not count as swims. Swimmers who compete in prelims and finals for a single event have two (2) chances to achieve his/her best time. The swimmers best time for that day will be the only time counted and will also count as one swim.

Housing:

Housing will be provided for your swimmers. Please email or fax your housing requests ASAP, and no later than November 20th! Include your arrival and departure times, (including an estimate on how many people will need transportation) so that transportation arrangements can be made for your team.
