1. What is a Leadership Summit?

The aim of the Leadership Summit is to provide leadership & governance training for high school aged athletes in Inland Empire Swimming. There has been a shortage of knowledge within the LSC on governance and leadership skills and this summit is directed at 13 and over athletes to give them training in both aspects.

2. Why should my child attend the leadership summit?

The Inland Empire Swimming leadership summit is meant to build athlete leaders within the LSC as well as each individual team. As an LSC and Athlete Committee we want to encourage athlete leadership both in and out of the pool and this training will provide many skills and techniques that can not be found anywhere else.

3. How long will the summit last?

The summit itself is scheduled to start at 8:00 AM. There will be an optional practice led by two of the LSC coaches beginning at 6:00. This practice is NOT REQUIRED and will not be any extra charge. This practice is REQUIRED for all TCCC swimmers as requested by Todd.

4. What is included in the cost of the summit?

Every session as well as lunch, several snacks and the optional morning practice. Each attendee will also be given a T-Shirt!

5. What does my child need to bring to the summit?

THEMSELVES! As well as a writing utensil! It is also recommended to eat a good breakfast before coming!

6. Is there a specific dress code for the summit?

There is no specific dress code however, dress appropriately and comfortably.

7. How do I send payment/pay for the summit?

Payment needs to be sent as a CHECK via mail to Todd Stafek (413 S. Arthur Place Kennewick, WA 99336) prior to the event with the athletes name.

8. Can I pay in the morning during check-in?

We will accept checks the day of the summit however, this will slow down the check in process and your child may not be able to participate if the payment is not made.

9. Will parents be able to stay and watch?

This is an athlete only event. Parents will be able to assist with registration if needed however drop-off and pick-up is recommended.

10. When will basic information about the summit be available after registration?

Basic information regarding the summit will be sent out shortly after the registration closes. Each athlete will be equipped with a “survival guide” with the schedule as well as any information they may need.
