LOCATION: Campbell County Aquatic Center, 800 E. Warlow Dr, Gillette, WY 82716

POOL: Indoor 50 meter pool, 10 lanes, non-turbulent racing lane markers, backstroke flags, Colorado Automatic Timing System. Lanes 3 – 10 will be used for competition. Lane 1 will be for warm up and cool down and Lane 2 will be a buffer lane.

ENTRY DEADLINE: Entries, hard copies and payment **MUST** be received by May 21, 2009

Late or deck entries will be accepted at the meet director's discretion.

RULES:

1. Current USA rules will prevail. The Head Referee shall have the final authority for conduct of the meet. All coaches, officials, and meet directors must have current USA cards on their person, in plain view, at all times.
2. All events will be swum as Timed Finals.
3. Whistle starts will be used.
4. Feet first entry only in the warm up pool. The warm up lane is to be used only for serious warm ups or cool downs.
5. The meet referee with concurrence with meet director may consolidate events in accordance with Section 102.1.4 of the USA Rules and Regulations.

6. Participating teams will be asked to provide timers for the meet.

- ELIGIBILITY: The meet is open to all swimmers currently registered with USA Swimming. No on deck registration will be allowed. **Clubs will be fined \$100 by Wyoming swimming, Inc. for any swimmer who does not meet current registration requirements.**
- AGE GROUPS: 12 & Under & Open. Age as of May 30, 2009, determines the age group.
- SCORING: There will be no scoring.
- AWARDS: There will be no awards.
- ENTRY FEES: \$25 fee per swimmer (includes \$5.00 WSI participation fee and \$5.00 facility surcharge). There will be no refunds. Payment must accompany entries with check made payable to: **Gillette Swim Team.**
- ENTRY LIMITS: Swimmers may compete in up to five (5) events.
- ENTRIES: All entries should be submitted on a 3.5" computer diskette using Hy-Tek or compatible software. Results will be returned on the same diskette. Hard copies of meet entries **MUST** accompany the diskette. In lieu of a diskette, entries may be submitted on a Master Sheet. Hard copies and Master Sheet will be the final authority on whether a swimmer is entered in an event. Email entries are accepted and **PREFERRED**. A signed registration verification must accompany all meet entries. Please include phone numbers or e-mail addresses of coaches or club representatives in case any changes or questions arise during the meet entry process.
- EVENTS: All events are timed finals.
- SEEDING: Events will be pre-seeded in times submitted in long course meters. At the discretion of the Head Referee events may be combined in a heat if there are too few entries in the event. A "no time" entry will be randomly seeded in to the slowest heats.
- CLERK OF COURSE: There will be no clerk of course. Heat and lane assignments will appear in the program. Swimmers are responsible for taking their positions behind the blocks.
- TIME TRIALS: There will be no time trials at this event.
- WARM UPS: Wyoming Swimming warm up procedures will be followed. Teams will be assigned lanes and times for warm up. The first portion of each warm up session will be for circle swimming only with feet first entry. The last ten minutes of each warm up session shall be for racing starts and one-way swimming only. A coach must supervise all swimmers during warm up.
- CONCESSIONS: Limited concessions and drinks will be available.
- FINAL RESULTS: Meet results can be picked up at the end of the meet. Meet results will also be available on the WSI website at <http://wyoming.usswim.net>.

Upon any team's request, hard copy results will be mailed to the team address provided.

SAFETY:

USA swimming has advised clubs to use safe warm up procedures in the conduct of meets. Swimmers will enter the pool feet first during all warm ups. No diving is allowed in the warm up pool. **Let's make this an accident free meet. Absolutely no glass containers or razors are allowed in the Aquatic Center. NO SMOKING IN THE AQUATIC CENTER OR ON AQUATIC CENTER GROUNDS.**
