



## **PARENT – CODE OF CONDUCT**

As a parent/guardian of a swimmer and member of Baldwin Whitehall Aquatics (BWA), I will abide by the following rules:

1. I will encourage my child to swim because I realize participation is voluntary.
2. I will not force my swimmer to participate in meets and/or events at any time.
3. I will make every effort to have my swimmer on pool deck in time for practices, meets or any other events.
4. It is my responsibility to notify the coaches of any injury or illness prior practices, meets or any other events.
5. I will not interrupt the coaches while coaching unless asked to do so or in an emergency.
6. I understand that I am not permitted on the pool deck during practices, meets or other events. If I have an issue that needs addressed I am to contact the coach via email.
7. I will ensure that my swimmer is picked up by an adult on time at the end of the session.
8. I understand that the officials who judge meets are volunteers and have the best interest of all swimmers in mind. If I have a question pertaining to a call/decision of an official I am to direct it to BWA coaching staff.
9. I will at all times demonstrate good sportsmanship.

BWA reserves the right to terminate any membership with/without cause in the interest of our vision, mission and objectives.
