

Good afternoon PVA families and swimmers,

As Thanksgiving approaches we wanted to reach out with a few reminders regarding travel guidelines that we are following as a club. Per the Massachusetts state guidelines, travelers entering the state or returning from out of state are required to either quarantine for 14 days after arrival or produce a negative COVID result from an administered test. As a club team and at the advice of our medical liaison we are asking that should you travel or invite friends/relatives into your homes from out of state and you do not wish to quarantine for 14 days, you please wait at least 4 days after arriving home and then get a COVID test. You will then need to provide PVA with the negative test result. Please also keep in mind that if you are planning to leave Massachusetts, you should abide by the state travel guidelines upon your return. We are requesting that, as members of PVA, you take this into account when planning your holidays and upcoming travel.

We understand that this kind of planning can feel daunting but also are reminded of how extremely grateful we are to have been able to offer practices this fall. We are even more appreciative to all of you for your time and diligence in following safety protocols. As our ability to count on regular routines has been shattered this year, having practices and this wonderful group of swimmers to coach on a consistent basis has been a blessing. We would like to ensure, to the best of our ability, that we are able to continue on this path and ask that you please assist us by following all safety guidelines as holidays approach.
