Meet Announcements/Reminders:

Warm-up & Sessions Start Times:

- Sessions on Friday-Saturday-Sunday will follow the times below.
 - Session "A" Prelims: Warm-up @ 7:00am; Meet start at 8:00am
 - Session "B" Timed Finals: Warm-up @ 12:00pm; Meet start at 1:00pm
 - Session "A" Finals: Warm-up @ 5:00pm; Meet start at 6:00pm
- Monday: Warm-up at 7:30am; Meet start at 8:30am

400 Free/400 IM Events:

- The deadline for positive check in for the 400 IM (Friday) and 400 Free (Saturday) will be
 - 9:00am for Prelims of the A sessions
 - 1:00pm for the "B" Timed Final sessions
- The top 8 swimmers in the 11-14 and top 8 swimmers in the 15&0 age groups in the 400 Free and 400 IM will swim during the Finals session. All of the other swimmers will compete in the prelim session. Prelim heats will run fastest to slowest, alternating heats of women and men.

800 Free (Monday):

- The deadline for positive check in for the 800 Free will be 8:00am for all swimmers in Events 177, 178, 31, and 32.
- The session will begin with Events 177 & 178 (11&O 800 Free). These heats will be seeded fastest to slowest, alternating heats of women and men. The slowest heats will be combined if there are less than 8 total athletes in the final heats.
- Events 31 & 32 will immediately follow Events 177& 178. These heats will be seeded fastest to slowest, alternating heats of women and men. The slowest heats will be combined if there are less than 8 total athletes in the final heats.
- Swimmers need to provide their own timer and lap counter for their race.

Facility Access:

- The facility will be open to event participants, teams, and coaches 30 minutes prior to the start of warm-up each day. Volunteers may enter the facility at their designated time.
- All participants, coaches, officials, volunteers and spectators should enter the facility through the main gate of the Cactus Aquatic Center.
- Locker room access will be available from the pool deck side of the facility.

Team & Family Seating:

- Additional shade structures have been rented to use throughout the meet. Out of state teams will have priority for these seating areas.
- Teams are welcome to bring their own team tents to create or expand their areas/
- Family tents are welcome as well. There should be no tents set up under existing shade structures or blocking walkways around the pool deck.

Concessions:

- The concession area will be located near the picnic tables at the shallow end of the pool. A variety of drinks and snacks will be available to purchase. Cash only.

Hospitality:

- Hospitality for coaches and officials will be located in the Aerobics Room, just off of the pool deck. All meals will be available to pick up throughout the meet, as well as snacks and drinks. A schedule of meals and times will be posted.
- Coolers with bottled water and other beverages will be located around the pool deck for coaches and volunteers.

Parking:

- In addition to the parking lots on either side of the Cactus Park, there will be overflow parking available in the large field adjacent to the park. Please follow the signs at the entrance of the facility. An off-duty police officer will be on site to help with traffic flow.

Ski Pro:

- Ski Pro will be at the meet starting on Friday morning and will have all equipment, suits, parkas, etc. for swimmers participating in the meet.
- They will be located near the concession area located at the shallow end of the pool.
