



Welcome to the 2021 Holiday Swim Festival at Arizona State University

It's back and bigger and better than ever! Please familiarize yourself with the spectator information so you know everything you need to know to have a great weekend!

This is a closed deck meet. Only swimmer/coaches/officials/registered volunteers are allowed on deck.

Spectator restrooms are available on the ground floor at the west end of the facility. Spectators are permitted in the vendor area on the west end of the facility. Tents are only permitted on the top row of the bleachers. Please keep all walkways clear and do NOT stand at the railing. Please note that tents may be collapsed, removed, or relocated by facility and event staff as needed.

Facility Access

As this is a USA Swimming event and deck access is restricted and enforced by security. Entrance to the facility can be gained through the east side emergency exit / entrance doors and via a pass list + wristband. All participants, Coaches and workers should exit through the east entrance and not the front lobby. Please allow extra time to navigate and access.

Parking

ASU does not offer free parking and operates on a pay by the hour basis - 7 days a week. While we cannot guarantee it, the parking structure gates are normally up on the weekends resulting in free parking. The Fulton Structure, just south of the Mona Plummer Aquatic Center and accessed via University Avenue or College Avenue, is another option that is far less affected by basketball and football game day parking. IMPORTANT NOTES:

1. Facility access times will be strictly adhered to. Please note the access times above.
2. Senior and Age Group Scratch rules are to be enforced. See meet flyer for details
3. If you are NOT assigned timing and can provide timers please be ready to volunteer if a call is made for timers---that's your ticket on deck!

CLOSED DECK: This meet has a firm closed deck policy. Only credentialed officials, coaches, and volunteers cleared by the meet director will be allowed access.

1. Officials should be properly dressed with visible credentials.
2. Coaches need to have credentials visible at all times, you will need to obtain a weekend coach wristband from the meet director or her designee.
3. Only those cleared **volunteers** displaying proper deck wrist band credentials will be allowed access. Timers will need to sign in each session and receive a wrist band in order to access the deck. Please make sure ALL volunteers check in at the volunteer table the session(s) they volunteer.

RESULTS: Results will be announced and posted on Meet Mobile (remember Meet Mobile is always unofficial). Official results will be posted in the entry area on the east end of the facility. Programs will be available for purchase for \$10, cash only.
