

**January 2021 Swim Meet Moon Valley Country Club
Phil Levine Invitational January 15-18. 2021**

The key is patience and flexibility. If you don't feel like you or your swimmer is ready to follow the restrictions described below than we ask for you to skip this meet and participate in future meets.



The following information is a supplement to the meet flyer

Meet Operations notes:

1. The walkway/golf cart path (shown by yellow arrow) must be kept clear at all times. Spectators may NOT set up chairs, or stop on OR AROUND the cart path.
2. Each session of the meet will be limited in order to comply with social distancing and group gathering guidelines. Separate warm up times may be designated to spread out swimmers during the warm up period.
3. Swimmers should have their temperature taken before they come to the meet. If it is over 100.4 degrees they may not participate.
4. All team set up will be in designated areas in the parking lot and surrounding areas. Masks must be worn at all times when on the MVCC property including in the parking lot. The pool area and designated set up area is approximately 100,000 square feet.
5. We will be using up to eight lanes for competition. Swimmers will be asked to remain behind the timers chairs until their heat is called to the blocks and remain physically distanced from the timers and all other individuals.
6. Swimmers should report behind the blocks no more than 2 heats before they swim. Officials will work with swimmers, when possible, to make sure swimmers don't miss their races.
7. Electronic timing will be used. One timer per lane will be needed.

8. All swimmers, coaches, marshals, and spectators must wear a face covering at all times unless directed otherwise by the meet referee.
9. A 4 lane warm up/warm down pool is available. Swimmers may NOT stop at the ends of the pool. Warm up pool is for continually swimming only.
10. Please refer to the facility picture on the first page. The star marks the only entry/exit to the pool area. The locker rooms will be closed. Absolutely no one is allowed in the Moon Valley Country Club Fitness Center. Swimmers should come dressed to swim and leave in their suits to change/shower at home. Restrooms are available outside the entry gate.
11. "Traffic" on the pool deck is "one way" only. Swimmers will approach the blocks from the south side of the pool before their race. Generally swimmers will be moving in a counter clockwise direction around the pool.
12. The deck at Moon Valley Country Club consists mostly of squares that are approximately 10'x10'. This provides a good visual for physical distancing.
13. **The pool deck will be closed to spectators.** To minimize crowds around the facility we ask that no more than one parent per household attend. This meet would be a good opportunity for swimmers to take responsibility for themselves at a meet. Printed results will NOT be posted at the meet, but will be posted on our website after each session.

Facility Rules

The meet we are hosting is a private event on private property. It is an event open to invited teams only. Nobody has a "right" to attend the meet as it is not open to the general public. The rules we are spelling out are a condition from the property owners in order for the meet to happen. **The rules apply to all people on the property, no exceptions.** They are non-negotiable. The information below is in addition to (and emphasizes points of) the guidelines that have been posted on the event page of the website.

1. **Masks must be properly worn at all times by all people on the property, including in the parking lot anytime you are not in your vehicle.** The only exception is swimmers in the water and going to/from the blocks. The meet referee has the authority to remove anyone from the meet who does not comply with the policy.
2. **The deck is closed** to all people except swimmers, coaches, officials, marshals, and timers. No spectators will be allowed on the pool deck at any time.
4. **The full length of the golf cart path must be kept clear at all times. This includes the rocks on each side and between the paths.** No set up (chairs, etc.) can occur on the cart path or in the areas in front of the entry gate or the restrooms.
5. Please exit the property promptly as soon as you are finished with your last event. Results will be on meet mobile (unofficial) and posted on the event page (official) as soon as possible after each session.
6. We encourage spectators to remain in your car during the meet. There will be a section of the parking lot that is blocked off for spectators. Masks are required in this area (as with all parts of the property). Social distancing from persons not in your household is required.
7. Our Marshals and crowd control personnel will enforce the above rules. They are all parent volunteers. Do not give them a hard time. Any non-compliance with their instructions or harassment of our volunteers will result in the offender being banned from the MVCC property and their swimmer removed from the meet.
8. No food or beverage service or concessions will be available at the meet.
9. MVCC Management and meet operations staff may introduce additional restrictions during the weekend if the need arises.
