



Volunteer Service Hour and Fundraising Obligation

The Halton Hills Blue Fins Swim Club is a Non-profit organization that depends on active parent/family volunteer and fundraising for the success of the club and to maintain a positive level of team and club spirit. Therefore, we require that every family commit to participating in the running of the club by volunteering their time and fundraising.

Over the course of the swim season, families earn Volunteer Service Hours (VSH), these hours go towards your Volunteer Service Hour Obligation with any remaining balance being billed at \$10.00/hour on June 1st 2021. All competent family members (aged 12 and over) can participate in order to earn the total hours required.

Fundraising is and will continue to be a very important component to our club's success. We are a small club and every contribution towards fundraising is critically important for the financial sustainability of the club. Each swimmer is responsible for contributing \$200.00 towards their Fundraising Obligation, we will continue to encourage different activities during the year to allow you to recover this amount. The activity participation is strictly voluntary, and you can opt out by simply paying your obligation if you choose to do so. Outstanding Fundraising Obligation amounts will be billed on June 1st, 2021.

Volunteer Service Hour Obligation

What is my Volunteer Service Hour Obligation?

Volunteer Service Hour Obligations are as follows:

Senior, Squad 2, Squad 1 = 25 VSH

Intro Comp, Intro = 15 VSH

How do I earn Volunteer Service Hours?

VSH can be earned throughout the season at Swim Meets (home and away), Fundraising Events and other areas that are communicated throughout the season. Each position, or job function is assigned an hour value. Working these positions throughout the year allow one to earn hours.

How are my Volunteer Service Hours tracked?

After each event a list of volunteers and the positions worked will be submitted to the Club Administrator. *It is the responsibility of all volunteers to ensure that their name has been recorded by the event coordinator.* The Club Administrator will enter hours accumulated by all families into TeamUnify. Families can check their Service Hours at any time by logging into your TeamUnify account.

Can hours be transferred or carried over to the following year?

Volunteer Service Hours must be collected within the current swim season and the total number of hours must be accumulated. They cannot be transferred or carried over.

Fundraising Obligation

What is my Fundraising Obligation?

Fundraising Obligations are as follows:

Senior, Squad 2, Squad 1, Intro Comp, Intro = \$200.00 per swimmer

How do I earn towards my Fundraising Obligation?

Our Fundraising Chair will be doing multiple Fundraising Events throughout the swim season. In the past, these events included Hockey Pools, Bottle Drive, Meat Fundraisers, Vesey's Bulb Fundraiser and our HHBF Golf Tournament.

How are my Fundraising Funds tracked?

After each event the amount of Fundraising Funds earned will be calculated by our Fundraising Chair and entered into TeamUnify. Families can check their Fundraising Obligation at any time by logging into their TeamUnify account.

Can Fundraising Obligation Funds be transferred or carried over to the following year?

Fundraising Obligation Funds must be collected within the current swim season and the total number of funds must be accumulated. They cannot be transferred or carried over.
