Please retain this copy of the Code of Conduct for your reference throughout the swim season. Infractions of the Swimmer Code of Conduct are contrary to the philosophy of the Halton Hills Blue Fins Swim Club and therefore will not be tolerated.

Respecting other athletes and coaches

Expectations include:

- cheering your team mates, helping younger swimmers
- following the directions of coaches to the best of your ability
- co-operating with adults in authority, including officials
- using polite language and exercising good manners
- keeping negative comments to yourself
- refraining from actions that insult, intimidate, humiliate, degrade or are malicious or offensive

Respecting property

Expectations include:

- behaving in a manner which does not result in damage
- respecting public property
- respecting the property of other swimmers

Appropriate behaviour and attire

Expectations include:

- obeying all rules
- assisting to ensure the safety of other swimmers
- obeying the mandatory swim meet team wear clothing policy

Any violations of these expectations will be addressed in the following manner:

1. Sanctions imposed by the Coach up to and including removal from regularly scheduled practice for a predetermined length of time;
2. Verbal warning issued by the President
3. Written notice issued by the Disciplinary Panel of the Board of Directors, including suspension from all Halton Hills Blue Fins events, including practice, meets and social functions for a one week period;
4. Suspension from all Halton Hills Blue Fins events for the remainder of the swim season.
