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Job Description

Instructors

SwimSkill Instructors will be responsible for teaching 45-minute swim lessons to swimmers aged five to twelve based on the SwimSkill Curriculum to groups of six to ten children depending on the level. Instructors are responsible for the safety and wellbeing of all students in their classes. Instructors are responsible for setting up the pool before the start of lessons. This includes putting up flags, putting in lane ropes, grabbing appropriate equipment and setting out lesson signs. Instructors are also responsible for cleaning up all equipment used at the end of lessons. A SwimSkill Instructor is someone who has their up to date Water Safety Instructor Certification, Bronze Cross and Bronze Medallion. All Staff 18 and older will be asked to complete a criminal record check, all employment is contingent on a successful criminal record check. Rate of pay is determined by experience. SwimSkill Instructors report to the SwimSkill Lesson Coordinator.

Jr Counsellor

Jr. Counsellors are responsible for assisting an instructor teach 45-minute swim lessons to swimmers aged five to twelve based on the SwimSkill Curriculum. Jr. Counsellors are responsible for setting up the pool before the start of lessons. This includes putting up flags, putting in lane ropes, grabbing appropriate equipment and setting out lesson signs. Jr. Counsellors are also responsible for cleaning up and putting away equipment at the end of lessons. A Jr. Counsellor at a minimum has their up to date Bronze Cross and Bronze Medallion and is at a minimum 14 years old. All Jr. Counsellors are paid minimum wage. Jr. Counsellors report to the SwimSkill Lesson Coordinator.
