



Meet Participation Fees, Meet Notification and Commitment Fees

Meet Participation Fees

- Meet fees are not included as part of swim dues, as such, during registration, each family is asked to provide two cheques, one for each term of swimming to cover these expenses.
- MST~ will set up and administer an escrow account for each swimmer.
- A tracking of all expenses can be found on the [Website](#) (on the right side list under my account, my invoices payment).
- A summary of the meet fees can be found in every meet package found on the [Website](#) (along the top under meets and results).
- Coaching fees are allocated towards coaches attending and supporting your swimmer during the swim meets.
- All remaining credits from your swimmers account will be carried over to the swimmer's account for the next season.

Meet Notification

- Notification of all meets will be sent out via email and can then be found on the website at the bottom of the home page under Events.
- Swimmers will automatically be signed up to participate in all events for all days of every meet available to them.
- In order to make adjustments parents are to log in to the website, scroll down the home page to events and click on the selected meet. Once in there, please click on your child's name and you can either confirm/decline attendance for the entire event or specific date. Comments can also be made to the coach as well in that online form.
- If you do not explicitly decline attendance for one or more days of the meet on the website, by the deadline, it will be presumed that the swimmer will be attending the meet and you will be responsible for all meet fees.

Commitment Fees

- During registration, each family is asked to provide two cheques, one for each term of swimming to cover commitment fees.
- As a club, hosting both inhouse and public meets it is essential to have parents participate in the meet, as there are many jobs needed to be completed.
- Commitment points are assigned by the position you volunteer at during the meet. Training is required for the majority of the roles and as such parents should participate in training certification through Swim Canada and there are both on line and in person trainings throughout the year. - The number of commitment points is correlated to which team your child swims with.
- Commitment points are per family, not per swimmer. For parents with more than one child in the club, your commitment points will be dictated by the child's team with the greatest number of points.
- Refunds will be issued at the end of the swim season provided conditions are met. Credits can be used against the following years Meet fees / Commitments.
- Partial refunds will be available to families achieving at minimum 85% of their points commitment. Anyone achieving less will not receive any refund.
- For any families not completing the year, until December 15th if the swim season a partial refund of commitment fees will be received based on participation in at least one meet. For any registration changes made after December 15th, there will be no refund available.
