This competition is open to all swimmers currently registered with Swimming Canada or a World Aquatics affiliated club.

ENTRIES

Entry Fees: Individual events
Preliminary/Final Event \$14/event
Timed Final \$12/event
Entry Fees are non-refundable after the entry deadline

Entry Deadline: Monday June 5, 2023 11:59PM

- Deck Entries: Deck Entries will be charged \$25.00/ event for all individual events.
All Deck Entries are exhibition swims and will not be scored.
- Refunds: No refunds for any scratched swimmers after Entry Deadline

Expected Entries:

- Maximum of 400 Swimmers and Minimum 200 swimmers
- Nose Creek Swim Association - reserved 150 swimmers

Entry Procedures:

- All entries to be submitted using Hy-tek through the Swimming Canada online system.
- All entries must contain the **swimmer's name, Swimming Canada swimmer ID and date of birth**. If entering from outside of Canada, please email the Hy-tek file directly to the entries email.
- Please enter all events with a time. NT's will not be accepted.
- Swimmers are limited to: 7 events (1 event Session 1, 2 events Session 2, 3 and 5)
- Deck entries will be limited to swimmers who have registered for the competition through the Swimming Canada online system and will be accepted as long as no new heats are created and at Meet Management's discretion. Deck entries must include proof that the swimmer is fully registered with Swimming Canada.

Official Split Time:

- Official Split time request deadline by 30 minutes before the start of the session in which the official split is requested. The coaches are required to fill "Official Split Request Form".
- There will be a fee of \$5.00 for each single official split request. The fee is payable to the Clerk of Course at the time of the request.

Age Groups:

Individual events

Results will be posted in the following age groups:

- Female: 10&under, 11-12, 13-14, 15 & over, Male: 11&under, 12-13, 14-15, 16 & over

MEET INFORMATION

Rules:

- The meet will be conducted under published World Aquatics and/or World Para Swimming rules and regulations supplemented by published and approved Swimming Canada and Swim Alberta rules and regulations. In addition, this meet package shall outline all changes to and specific application of the published rules. Swim Alberta policies and procedures, where appropriate will also apply.
- Swimming Canada warm-up procedures will be in effect.

Modesty Wear

- All swimmers are permitted to race with modesty wear at all competitions sanctioned by Swim Alberta. It is not required to declare the use of modesty wear to the Referee.
Modesty wear is considered additional body coverage using a fabric that is a permeable open mesh textile and would not reasonably be seen to be creating a technical advantage, meaning it does not aid buoyancy, strength, speed, or endurance.

Safe Sport:

- All interactions between an athlete and an individual who is in a position of trust should normally, and wherever possible, be in an environment or space that is both “open” and “observable” to others.

Competition and Diving Readiness Standards:

- Entry to competition is limited to participants who have passed Swim Alberta’s Competition Swim Test. During competition, swimmers should dive at the Dive Readiness Progression skill level they have achieved.

Diving Rules:

- Starts will be conducted from Starting Platforms (blocks) as per World Aquatics FR 2.3, FR 2.7 and SW 4.1.

Meet Format – Timed Final and Preliminary Events

- All events will be swum slowest to fastest, with the exception of 400 Free, 400 IM, 800 Free, 1500 Free will be swum fastest to slowest.
- “A” & “B” finals for 50 and 100 events - will only be run if 16 swimmers entered in event (not including exhibition swimmers).
- “A” final will be swum first followed by the “B” final.
- 400 Free, 400 IM, 800 Free and 1500 Free: Positive Check-in 30 minutes before session start. The 800 and 1500 may be limited to top 24 each gender, based on session timeout.

Deck Entries:

- Deck Entries will be “Exhibition” only and accepted only if the entry does not create a new heat.

Deadlines

Last Minute Scratch Deadline (no refunds if after June 5, 2023)	Thursday June 22, 2023 by Noon
Late Scratch Deadline	30 minutes prior to the start of the session
Deck Entry Deadline	30 minutes prior to the start of the session
Official Split Deadline	30 minutes prior to the start of the session

Scratches:

- **The Swim Alberta Scratch Rule will be in effect for this competition.**
- To make the meet run more efficiently any last minute scratches would be appreciated until Thursday June 22, 2023 by Noon. Please notify us by email, entries@ncsaswim.ca.

Awards:

- Top 3 swimmers of “A” finals will receive medals, ribbons for 4-8th place.
- Bell Ringer heat winner prizes will be awarded.

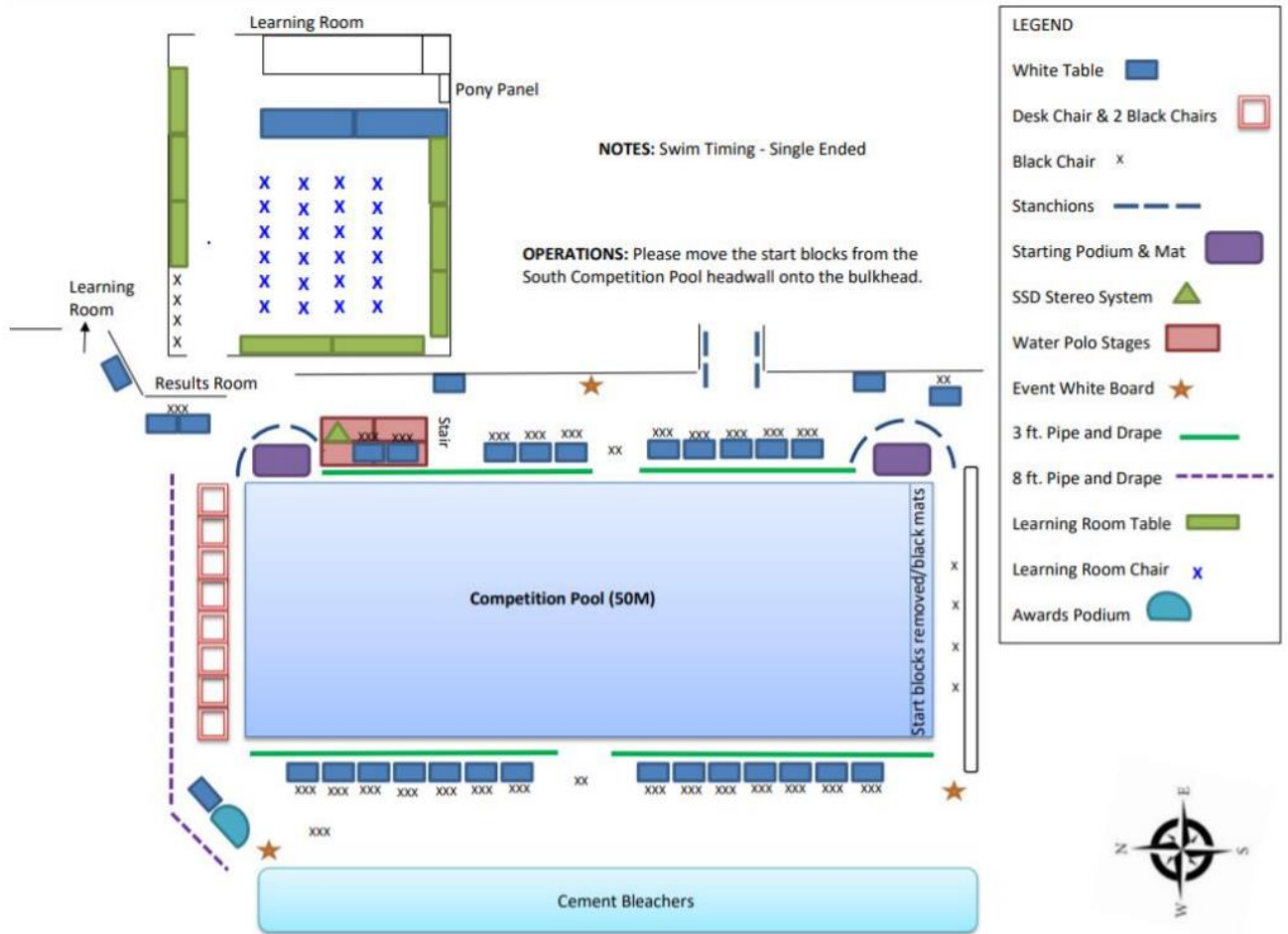
